#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

#### I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Guddu & Sukkur is in Medium flood level. River Indus at Kalabagh, Chashma, Taunsa, River Ravi at Balloki & Sidhnai and River Sutlej at Sulemanki are in Low flood level.

#### **II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Mild moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 3000 feet.
- b. Seasonal low lies over Northwest Balochistan.

#### III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Mainly dry weather is expected over most parts of country however isolated wind thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Northeast Balochistan, Islamabad along with DIKhan ,Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, & DGKhan Divisions.

#### IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

No significant change is expected.
