SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND OUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST: I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala Guage height (as per WAPDA telemetric 25.40 feet, as per

irrigation 19.10 feet). All the other Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows.

Medium to High Level Flooding is expected in River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala during next 48 hours.

- II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:
- a. A fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Iran.
- b. Light to moderate Moist currents from Arabian sea are penetrating upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- c. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.
- III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Mainly dry weather is expected over most parts of the country. However, Isolated thunderstorm/rain

is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Sutlej, Ravi & Chenab along with Gujranwala,

Sargodha & Lahore Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK 48-HOURS:

Scattered thunder storm/ rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of

all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore,

Faisalabad, Sahiwal & Bahawalpur Divisions.
