SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

River Chenab at Qadirabad is in Low Flood Level, while all the other Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows.

<u>Alert</u>: Medium to High Level Flooding is expected in River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala during next 72 hours.

- II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:
- a. Yesterday's deep trough of westerly wave over Kashmir & adjoining areas has moved away
- b. Moist currents are temporarily cut off.
- c. Weak Seasonal low lies over Northwest Balochistan.
- III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered thunderstorm / rain is expected over the upper catchment of River Sutlej. Isolated thunderstorm/rain expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers except River Sutlej. Mainly dry weather is expected over rest of the country.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK 48-HOURS:

No significant change.
