#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

#### HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Chashma & River Sutlej at Sulemanki are in Medium flood level. River Indus at Tarbela, Kalabagh, Taunsa, Guddu & Sukkur, River Kabul at Nowshera and River Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala are in Low flood level.

ALERT: Flash flooding is expected in the Tributaries of River Kabul & Hill torrents of DG Khan Division from 27th to 30th July

#### II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. A Well marked low pressure area has developed over Northwest Bay of Bengal.
- b. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of Afghanistan persists.
- c. Light currents from Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet, Currents from Arabian Sea are likely to intensify.
- d. Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.

#### III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DIKhan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Multan, DG Khan, Bahawalpur, Zhob, Loralai, Kalat, Sibbi, Makran & Nasirabad Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over upper Sindh .

#### IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Monsoon activity is likely to increase over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Rawalpindi, Gujranwala & Lahore Divisions.
