#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

## I: <u>HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:</u> River Kabul at Nowshera is in Low Flood Level, while all the other Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows.

- II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:
- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Kashmir and adjoining areas has moved away Eastwards.
- b. Mild moist currents from Arabian sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 3000 feet.
- c. Seasonal low lies over Northwest Balochistan.

#### III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Mainly dry weather is expected over most parts of the country, however thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity at Isolated places is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad, Punjab, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa along with Kalat Division.
