#### SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

#### HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION: I:

River Kabul at Nowshera is in Low Flood Level, while all the other Major Rivers are flowing in the state of

their normal flows.

#### **II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Kashmir and adjoining areas persists.
- b. Yesterday's low-pressure area over Northwest Madhya Pradesh has become insignificant.
- c. Mild moist currents from Arabian sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over Northwest Balochistan.

#### **III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with heavy falls at one or two places is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, D.I Khan, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan, Bahawalpur & D.G Khan, Divisions.

#### **IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:**

Rainfall activity is likely to subside.
