SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

River Indus at Taunsa & Guddu and River Sutlej at Sulemanki are in Medium flood level. River Indus at Tarbela, Kalabagh, Chashma & Sukkur, River Kabul at Nowshera, River Chenab at Marala and River Ravi at Balloki & Sidhnai are in Low flood level. Moderate Flash flooding is expected in the Hill torrents of DG Khan Division along with tributaries of River Kabul during next 24 hours.

ALERT: Due to combining effect of Downstream discharges from Taunsa and Punjnad, River Indus at GUDDU may attain High Flood level on 30th July-2023 at SUKKUR on 31st July-2023.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of the country persists.
- b. Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- c. Seasonal low lies over Northeast Balochistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad, Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, upper Sindh and Zhob, Loralai, Kalat, Sibbi, Makran & Nasirabad Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet spell is likely to decrease.
