SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION: Ŀ

River Kabul at Nowshera and River Indus at Chashma are in Low Flood Level.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over northern parts of the country, today lies over Kashmir and а. adjoining areas.
- b. Yesterday's low-pressure area over Northeast Madhya Pradesh today lies over Northwest Madhya Pradesh.
- Mild moist currents from Arabian sea are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- d. Seasonal low lies over Northeast Balochistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with heavy falls at one or two places is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, DG Khan, Zhob & Sibbi Divisions. Isolated to Scattered wind thunderstorm /rain is expected over Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan, Bahawalpur, Naseerabad & Kalat Divisions along with Southeast Sindh.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK:

Present wet spell is likely to subside after 48-hours.
