SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

River Kabul at Nowshera is in Low Flood Level, while all the other Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Flash flooding is expected in the Hill Torrents of D.G Khan Division and tributaries/local nullahs of River Kabul during 26th June to 28th June 2023. Flows are also likely to increase (Low level) in the Nullahs of River Ravi (Basantar Sakki, Deg) and River Chenab (Bhimber, Palku, Aik) during the same period.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeast Afghanistan today lies over Kashmir & adjoining areas and a fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northeastern parts of Iran.
- b. Moderate moist currents from Arabian sea and Bay of Bengal are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.
- c. Yesterday's low pressure area over Northwest Bay of Bengal has moved Westwards and today lies over North Orrisa.
- d. Seasonal low lies over Northeast Balochistan and its trough is extending Northwards.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Widespread thunderstorm/rain with moderate to heavy falls is at scattered places is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Bahawalpur & DG Khan Divisions. Scattered to widespread thunderstorm /rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Jhelum, Indus and Kabul along with Sargodha, Faisalabad, Multan, Zhob, Sibbi, Nasirabad & Kalat Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR SUBSEQUENT TWO DAYS:

Wet spell is likely to continue.
