



PDMA Balochistan: 4x Deaths has not been added as the incident occurred in May 2025. Addition of 8x Deaths has been updated in NDMA's SitRep. These deaths were reported by PDMA Balochistan during the period of 19 - 30 Sept.

PDMA Punjab: 13x deaths occurred during the period from 19 September 2025 to 30 September 2025. Additionally, the 5 tourists from Lodhran who died due to a flash flood at Babusar Top in August 2025 have also been included in the Punjab SitRep.

GBDMA: 10x tourist death figures have been removed from the GBDMA SitRep, as the tourists were from Lodhran (5x) and Mardan (5x) died due to a flash flood at Babusar Top, Diamir.

PDMA KP: 5x tourist from Mardan died due to flash flood at Babusar Top in August 2025 has also been added in KP Sitrep.






GBDMA: GBDMA has reported 92 bridges during the entire monsoon season at different times, out of which district-wise segregation for 5 bridges is still awaited.


