7. <u>Weather Forecast for Next 24 Hours by PMD</u>. Scattered thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Islamabad, South & Southeast Sindh, East Balochistan and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad, and DG Khan Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Sahiwal, Multan, and Bahawalpur Divisions.

9. <u>Weather Advisory / Press Release</u> In response to PMD weather alert NDMA has issued weather advisory to all concerned on 6th September 2021 that more Monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in the country from Tuesday (evening/night) till Saturday (07th – 11th September 2021). Under the influence of this weather system:

Rain-wind-thundershower is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Okara, Faisalabad, Sargodha, Mianwali, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Charsadda, Nowshera, Dir, Chitral, Peshawar, Kohat, Waziristan, Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamir, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche and Kharmang) with occasional gaps from Tuesday (evening/ night) till Saturday (07th – 11th September 2021).

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
