SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:

All the Major Rivers are flowing Below Low Flood level. Low to Medium flood Level is expected at Nullah Deg (Kingra) during next 48-hours.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Kashmir and adjoining areas has moved away Eastwards and a fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Iran.
- Yesterday's low Pressure over West Rajasthan persists.
- Strong moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating to Sindh and Eastern Balochistan up to 7000 feet. Light to moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal are penetrating to Central Punjab up to 5000 feet.
- d. Weak Seasonal low lies over West Balochistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to widespread wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate to heavy intensity is expected over South Sindh & Eastern Balochistan. Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Islamabad along with Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, D.I Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad & Sahiwal Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over Multan, D.G Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions.
