Subject: **FLOOD ADVISORY - RIVER KABUL AND INDUS (MEDIUM TO HIGH FLOOD)**

Water flows in **River Kabul at Nowshera and its tributaries / nullahs** will reach **MEDIUM TO HIGH FLOOD LEVELS** Flows from **2200 PST** of **15th August 2025** to **2200 PST** of **16th August 2025**, River Indus at Kalabagh will reach **MEDIUM TO HIGH LEVEL FLOWS** from **0800 PST** of **16th August 2025** to **0800 PST** of **17th August 2025** and River Indus at **Chashma** will reach **MEDIUM TO HIGH LEVEL FLOWS** from **1600 PST** of **16th August 2025** to **1600 PST** of **17th August 2025**; *Flood Forecasting Division Warning No A-06/2025 dated 15 August 2025 attached as **Annex-A***. All concerned Federal Ministries / Departments, PDMA Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, PDMA Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Irrigation Department, Punjab Irrigation Department Respective District Administration(s) / DDMA(s), Municipal / City Administration(s) are advised to ensure following: -

- a. Identification of **vulnerable points / at-risk communities** and devise **mitigation and safety measures**.
- b. Maintain **enhanced alert level / monitoring** of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
- c. All civil agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to **remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment** during the next 48 hours, especially in at-risk areas.
- d. People living along the banks of River Kabul & Indus and its associated Nullahs to be **sensitized about expected increase of water flows**.
- e. Timely **evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood prone areas** as per Evacuation Plans and availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps.
- f. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be **forewarned to shift cattle away from low lying areas** adjacent to River Kabul and its associated Nullahs.
- g. Restrict vehicle movement in **low lying / at-risk areas**, close to River Kabul & Indus and its associated water channels / nullahs.
- h. Provision of **POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations** and timely **pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding**.
- i. DISCOs and relevant Local Administration / Departments to **ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken** to avoid electrocution incidents and

timely restoration of power supply.

- j. Provision of **relief / medical supplies to affectees** in timely manner.
 - k. Coordinate with concerned departments for **clearance of roads** in case of any blockage / obstruction & waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
 - l. Travellers and Tourists are **forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas** with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
 - m. In case of any eventuality, **Special SITREP / Update** be shared immediately with NDMA.
2. **Flood Forecasting Division Only.** Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, **especially River Kabul every 3 hours** with NDMA.
3. **Press Information Department Only.** With the request for **wider circulation and public awareness.**

SIGNIFICANT FLOOD WARNING


According to the Latest hydrometeorological conditions

1. **River Kabul at Nowshera** is likely to attain **Medium to High Level Flows** from 2200PST of 15th August-2025 to 2200PST of 16th August-2025.
2. **River Indus at Kalabagh** is likely to attain **Medium to High Level Flows** from 0800PST of 16th August-2025 to 0800PST of 17th August-2025.
3. **River Indus at Chashma** is likely to attain **Medium to High Level Flows** from 1600PST of 16th August-2025 to 1600PST of 17th August-2025.

All concerned authorities are advised to remain **“ALERT”** and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period.
