Subject: FLOOD ADVISORY - RIVER KABUL AND INDUS (MEDIUM TO HIGH FLOOD)

Water flows in River Kabul at Nowshera and its tributaries / nullahs will reach MEDIUM TO HIGH FLOOD LEVELS Flows from 2200 PST of 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025 to 2200 PST of 16<sup>th</sup> August 2025, River Indus at Kalabagh will reach MEDIUM TO HIGH LEVEL FLOWS from 0800 PST of 16<sup>th</sup> August 2025 to 0800 PST of 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025 and River Indus at Chashma will reach MEDIUM TO HIGH LEVEL FLOWS from 1600 PST of 16<sup>th</sup> August 2025 to 1600 PST of 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025; Flood Forecasting Division Warning No A-06/2025 dated 15 August 2025 attached as Annex-A. All concerned Federal Ministries / Departments, PDMA Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, PDMA Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Irrigation Department, Punjab Irrigation Department Respective District Administration(s) / DDMA(s), Municipal / City Administration(s) are advised to ensure following: -

- a. Identification of vulnerable points / at-risk communities and devise mitigation and safety measures.
- b. Maintain **enhanced alert level / monitoring** of developing situation to reduce reaction / response times.
- c. All civil agencies / rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during the next 48 hours, especially in at-risk areas.
- d. People living along the banks of River Kabul & Indus and its associated Nullahs to be sensitized about expected increase of water flows.
- e. Timely evacuation of at-risk population from low-lying / flood prone areas as per Evacuation Plans and availability of shelter, food and medicines in those shelter camps.
- f. Locals / farmers / cattle herders be **forewarned to shift cattle away from low**lying areas adjacent to River Kabul and its associated Nullahs.
- g. Restrict vehicle movement in low lying / at-risk areas, close to River Kabul & Indus and its associated water channels / nullahs.
- h. Provision of POL for back-up generators at water pumping stations and timely pre-placement of de-watering equipment for de-flooding.
- i. DISCOs and relevant Local Administration / Departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and

- timely restoration of power supply.
- j. Provision of relief / medical supplies to affectees in timely manner.
- k. Coordinate with concerned departments for **clearance of roads** in case of any blockage / obstruction & waterlogging and pre-placing of necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / appropriate locations.
- I. Travellers and Tourists are forewarned about risks posed at flood vulnerable locations and may be diverted to safe lay-by / waiting areas with sufficient supply of water / food and essential medicines in case of adverse / dangerous road conditions by Police, NH&MP and Local Administrations.
- m. In case of any eventuality, **Special SITREP / Update** be shared immediately with NDMA.
- 2. <u>Flood Forecasting Division Only</u>. Please share regular updates on water flows on major rivers, **especially River Kabul every 3 hours** with NDMA.
- 3. <u>Press Information Department Only</u>. With the request for wider circulation and public awareness.
- 4. Forwarded for information / necessary action, please.

### SIGNIFICANT FLOOD WARNING

According to the Latest hydrometeorological conditions

- 1. River Kabul at Nowshera is likely to attain Medium to High Level Flows from 2200PST of 15th August-2025 to 2200PST of 16th August-
- River Indus at Kalabagh is likely to attain Medium to High Level 2. Flows from 0800PST of 16th August-2025 to 0800PST of 17th August-
- 3. River Indus at Chashma is likely to attain Medium to High Level Flows from 1600PST of 16th August-2025 to 1600PST of 17th August-

All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period.
