

NDMA - MONSOON RAINS - MULTIPLE MODEL PROJECTION (8 JULY 2023 - 1100 hrs)

FORECASTED IMPACT

- Possibility of severe thunderstorms / heavy rainfall in North / Northeastern Punjab (including Lahore, Sialkot & Narowal).
- Potential for urban flooding in municipal areas and landsliding in hilly regions.
- Potential **thunderstorms** / **heavy rainfall** in Sindh (*Karachi, Tharparkar, Sukkur, Larkana, Hyderabad, Badin, Shaheed Benazirabad*).
- Possibility of thunderstorms in Northeastern Balochistan (Sibbi, Zhob, Kohlu, Q. Saifullah, Khuzdar, Barkhan, Loralai, Dera Bugti & Lasbela).
- Rainfall expected in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Bannu, DI Khan, Malam Jabba, Balakot).

GUIDANCE ISSUED

- City / District Administrations are to ensure contingency traffic plans for areas vulnerable to flooding in cities, (especially in Lahore, Gujranwala, Sialkot and Faisalabad) catering for prompt de-watering operations in flooded underpasses.
- All District Administrations to ensure completion of stock taking and reconnaissance and public awareness / information in vulnerable areas, especially Marala Headworks on River Chenab and Jassar on River Ravi with respect to chances of flood flows until 20 July.
- Rescue Services and leading NGOs will ensure availability of personnel in the indicated areas.
- All stakeholders to maintain proactive coordination in order to ensure prompt and streamlined response down to grassroots level.
