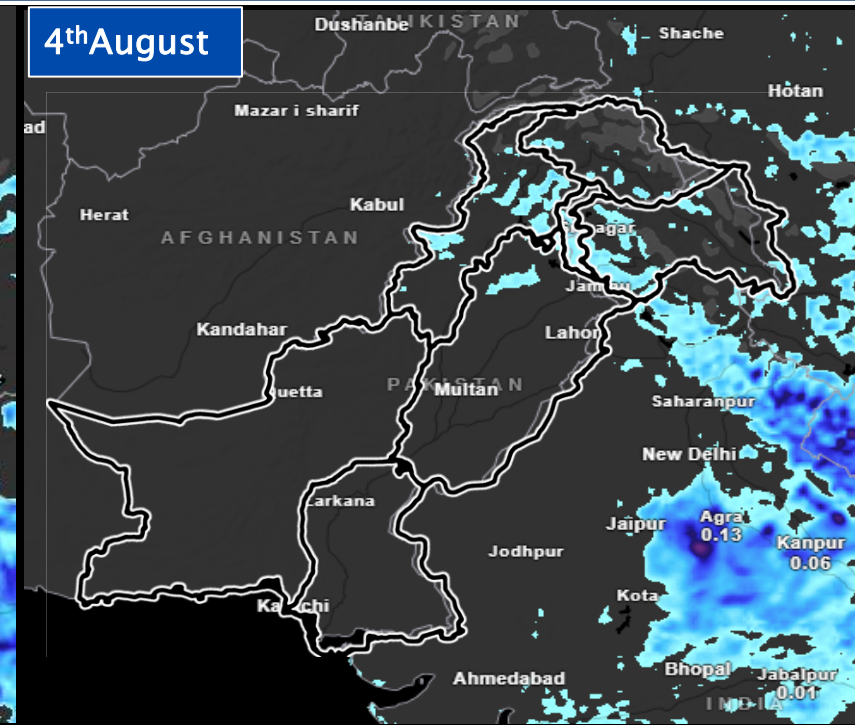
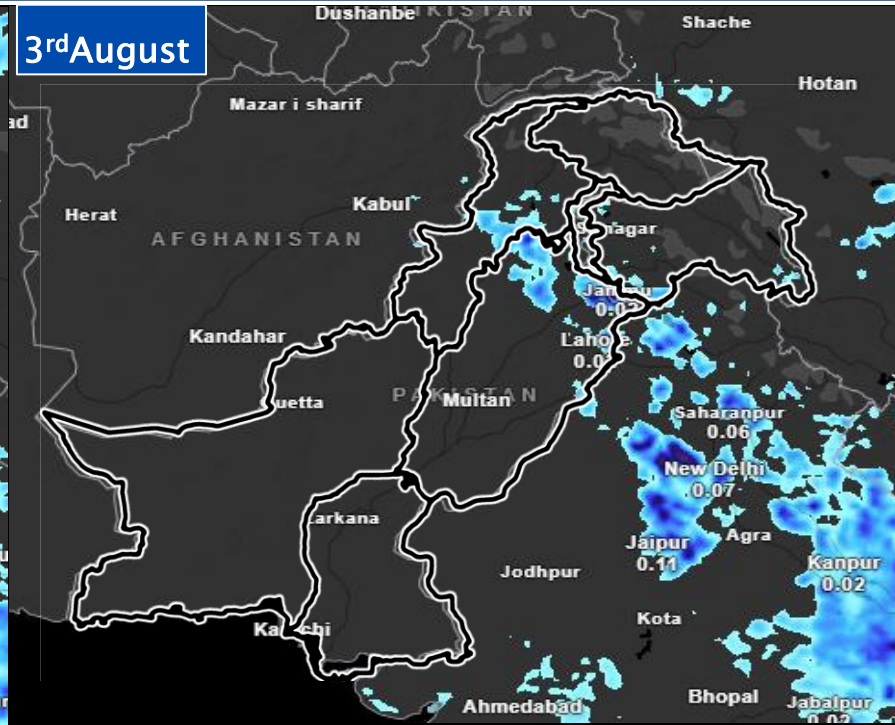
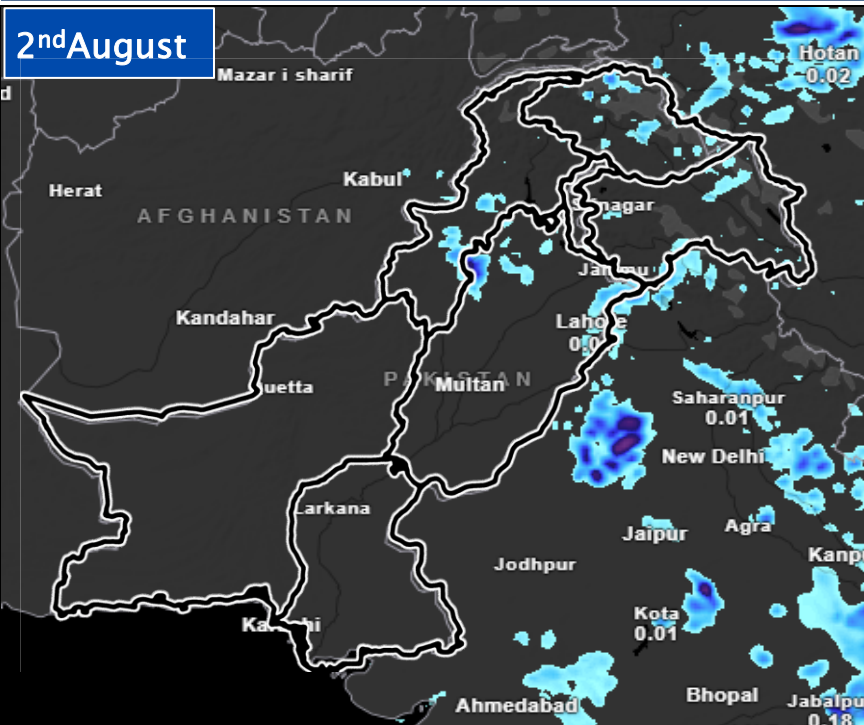




Weather Advisory (2nd to 7th August, 2025)

National Emergency Operation Centre – National Disaster Management Authority



Moisture from the Bay of Bengal and the Arabian Sea, coupled with the influence of low-pressure systems developing in the surrounding regions, is expected to bring moderate to heavy rainfall across most parts of the country during 5th to 7th of August, 2025.

Punjab:

Moderate/isolated heavy rainfall is expected in upper and northeastern parts of the province including Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Hafizabad, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Okara, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Multan, and surrounding areas from 5th to 7th of August, 2025. However, isolated rainfall is expected in Pothohar region throughout the week.

Balochistan:

Maily hot and humid weather is expected in all parts of the province from 2nd to 7th of August, 2025.

Sindh:

Maily hot and humid weather is expected in all parts of the province from 2nd to 7th of August, 2025.

KP:

Low to moderate rainfall is expected in Chitral, Dir, Haripur, Karak, Kohat, Kohistan, Khyber, Kurram, Mansehra, Mohmand, Nowshera, Malakand, Charsadda, Abbottabad, Bannu, Buner, Hazara, Peshawar, Swabi, Swat, Waziristan, and surrounding areas from the 2nd to 4th of August 2025. However, rainfall is likely to intensify, with moderate to isolated heavy falls expected from the 5th to 7th of August 2025.

GB & AJK:

Isolated rainfall is expected in Astore, Skardu, Hunza, Shighar and surrounding areas. However, moderate rainfall is expected in Bagh, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, and surrounding areas from 2nd to 7th of August, 2025 with occasional gaps.
