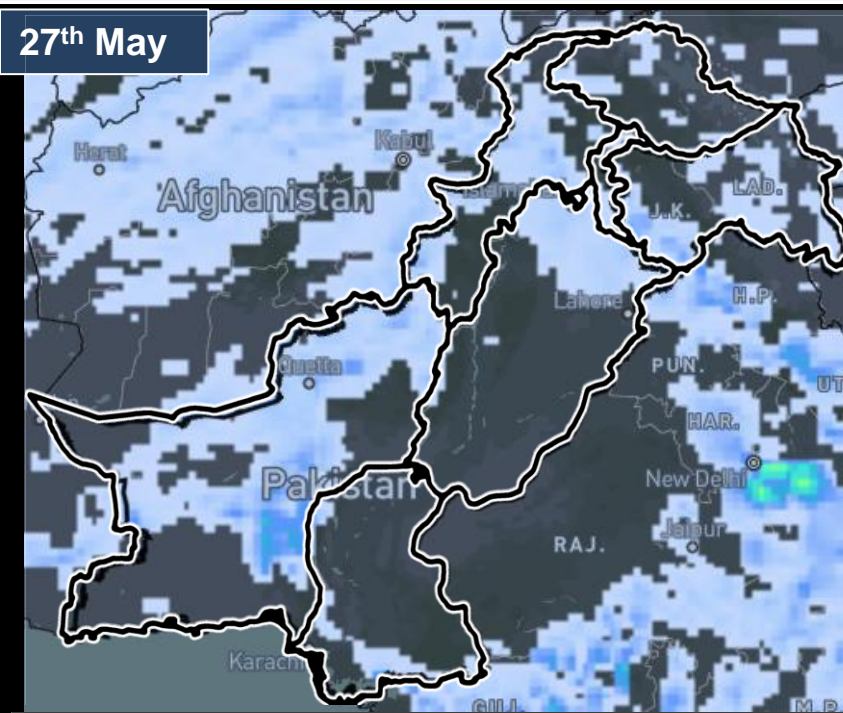




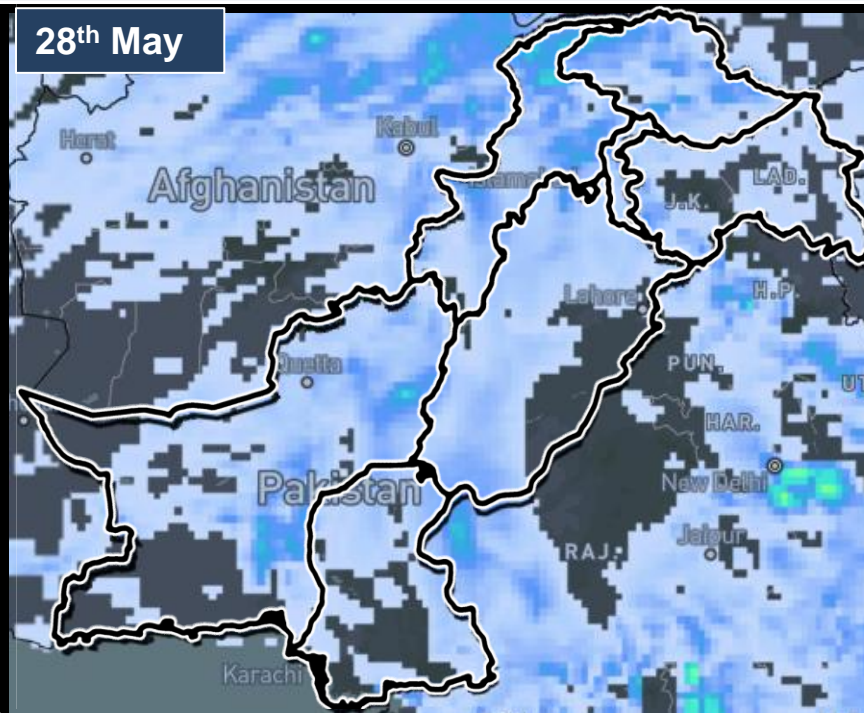
Weather Advisory (May 27th to June 1st, 2025)

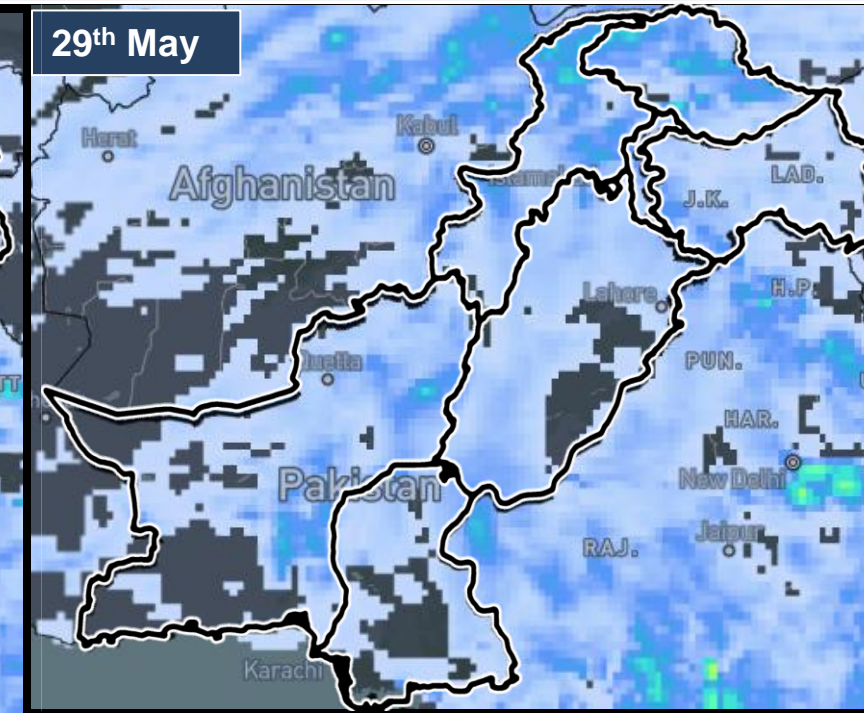

A significant weather system is expected to impact various regions of Pakistan from May 27 to 29, 2025, due to a western disturbance interacting with moist currents from the Arabian Sea. The system will impact particularly in the upper and central parts of the country.

Punjab:

Heavy rainfall, thunderstorms, windstorms, and duststorms are expected from 27th to 29th of May, 2025 in various parts of the province including Mianwali, Sargodha, Islamabad, Jhelum, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Sialkot, Gujar Khan, Lahore, Narowal, Multan, Khanewal, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Dera Ghazi Khan and surrounding areas. Isolated hailstorms are also expected during this time period.

Balochistan:

Rain, windstorms, and thunderstorms are expected in northern and eastern Balochistan including Kalat, Khuzdar, Pishin, Quetta, Zhob, and Ziarat from 27th to 29th May.

Sindh:

Rain, windstorms and thunderstorms are expected in upper and southeastern parts of Sindh including Sukkur, Mirpurkhas, Khairpur, Tharparkar, Badin, Thatta, Tharparkar, Hyderabad, Karachi and surrounding areas from 27th to 29th May.

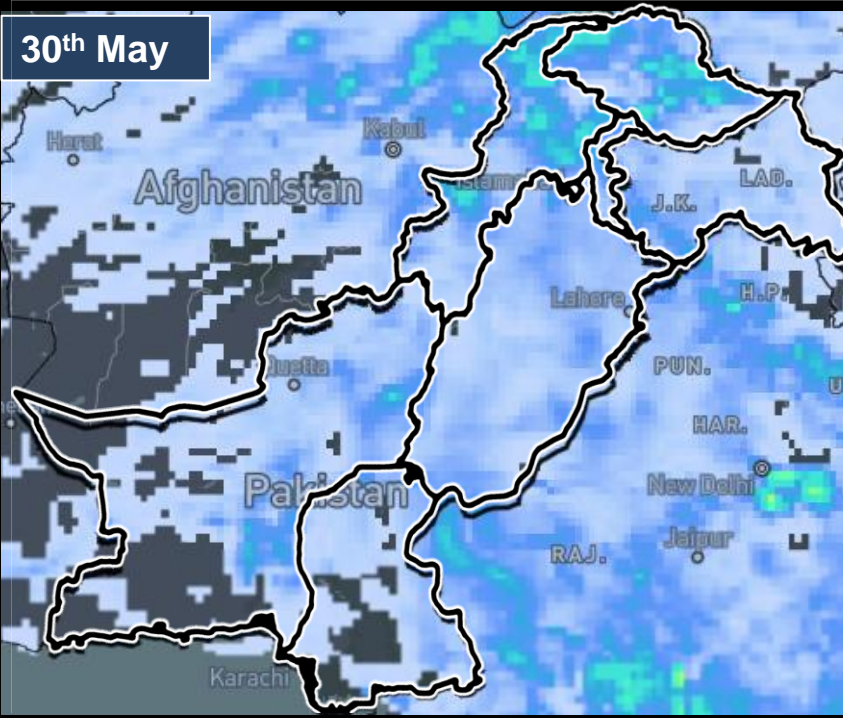
KP:

Heavy rainfall, thunderstorms, windstorm and isolated hailstorm is expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Abbottabad, Mansehra, Haripur, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Malakand, Waziristan, Kohat, Lakki Marwat, Bajaur, Mohmand, Karak, Khyber, Peshawar, Mardan, Kurram, Mansehra, Abbottabad and surrounding areas from the evening of 27th of May to 1st June, 2025.

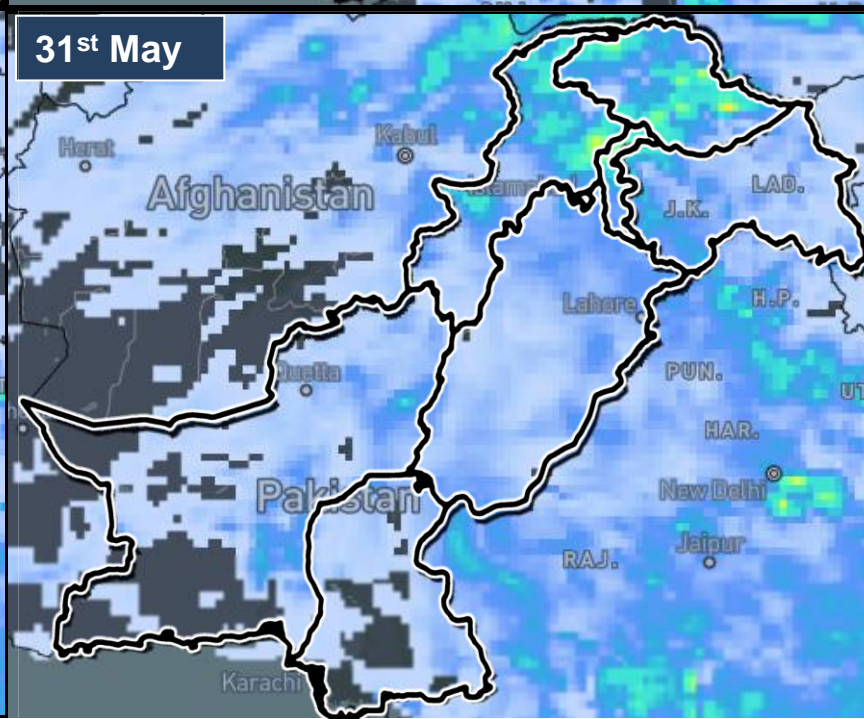
GB & AJK:
