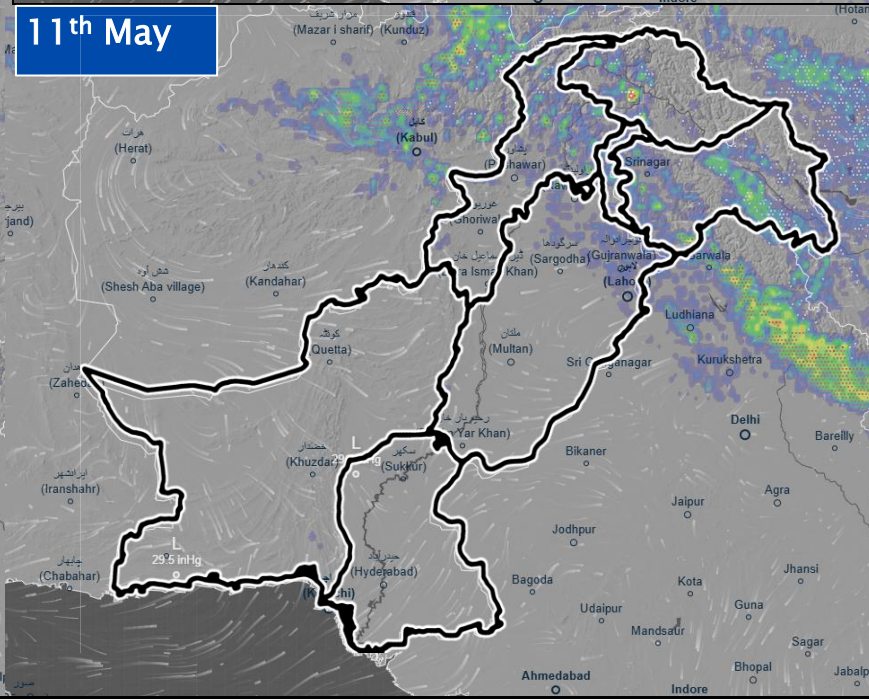
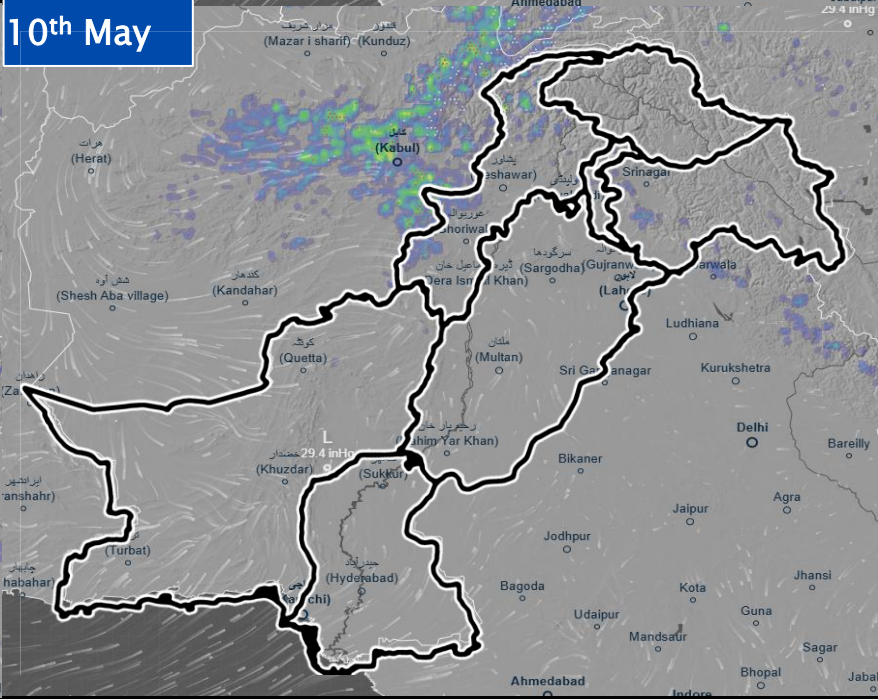
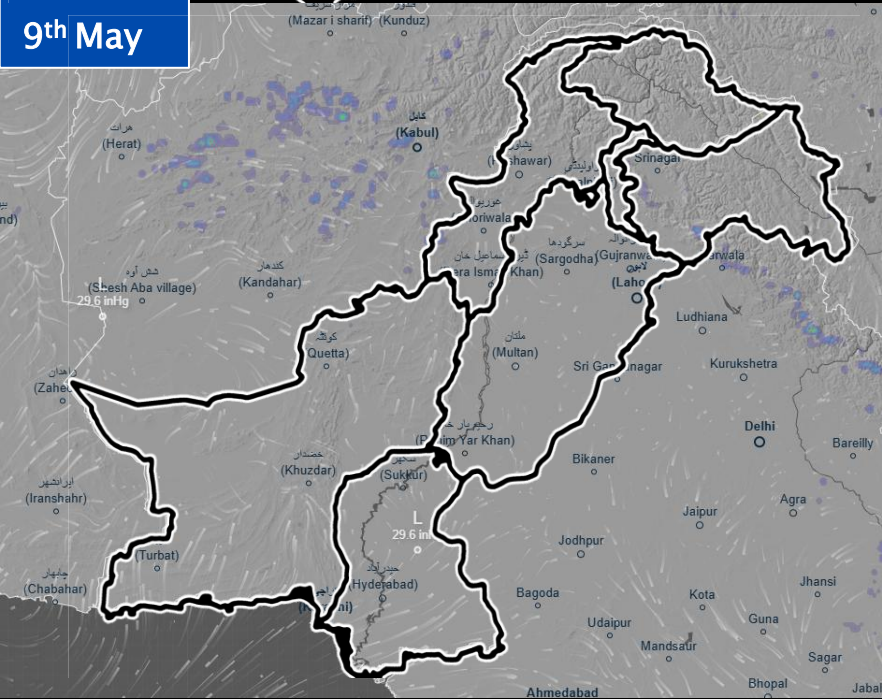
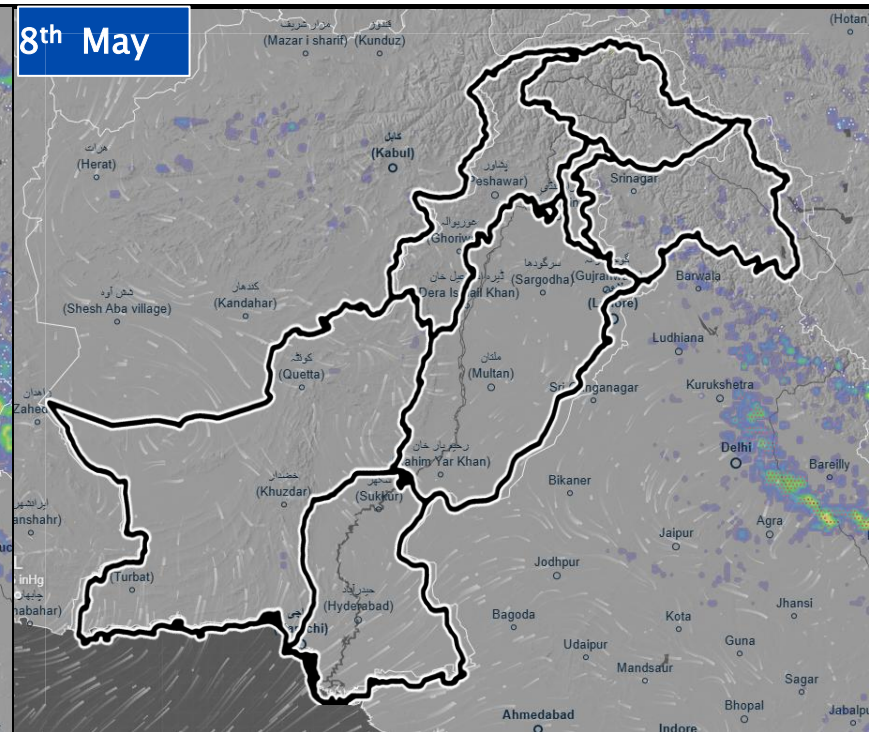
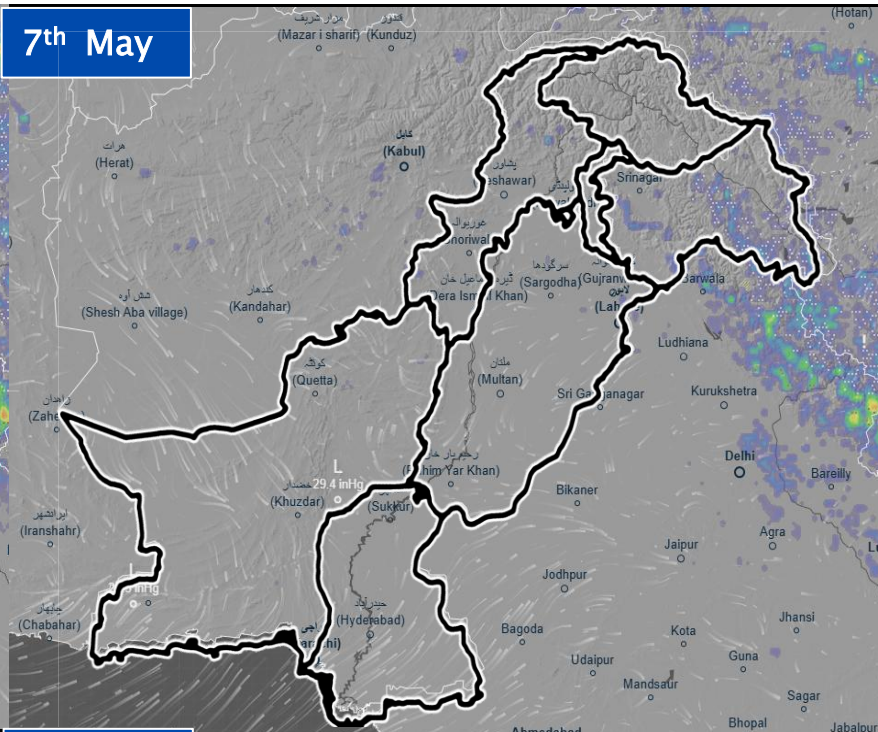
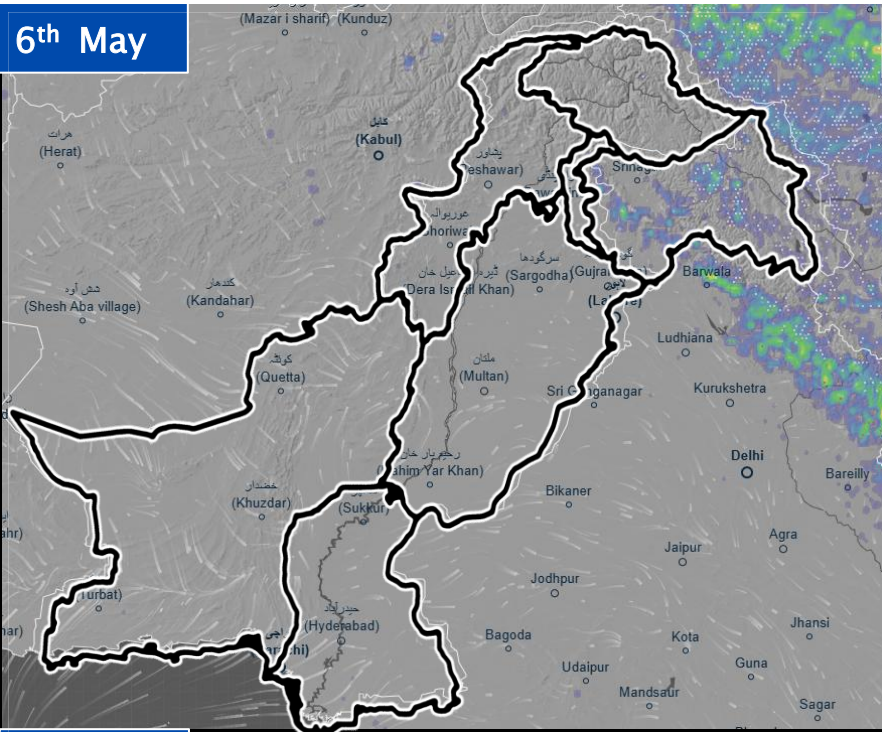




Weather Advisory (6th May to 11th May, 2026)

Punjab:

Dry and warm weather is expected from 6 May to 10 May. However, on 11 May upper Punjab is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm in districts including Rawalpindi, Islamabad, Murree, Attock, Jhang, Gujar Khan, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal, Kasur, Lahore and surrounding areas. Temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.

Balochistan:

The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry. Temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.

Sindh:

The province is expected to remain mainly hot and dry. Temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.

KP:

Dry and warm weather is expected from 6 May to 9 May. However, on 10 May and 11 May western KP is expected to experience isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm in districts including Chitral, Dir, Mingora, Mansehra, Abbotabad, Haripur, Mardan, Nowshera, Charsadda, Peshawar, Landi Kotal and surrounding areas. Temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.

GB & AJK:

Dry and warm weather is expected from 6 May to 10 May. However, on 11 May isolated rainfall, thunderstorm, windstorm, and isolated hailstorm is anticipated in Gilgit, Skardu, Hunza, Ghizer, Diamer, Astore, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Bhimber, Mirpur, Kotli, Bagh, Garhi Duppatta and surrounding areas. Temperature will also steadily rise throughout the province.
