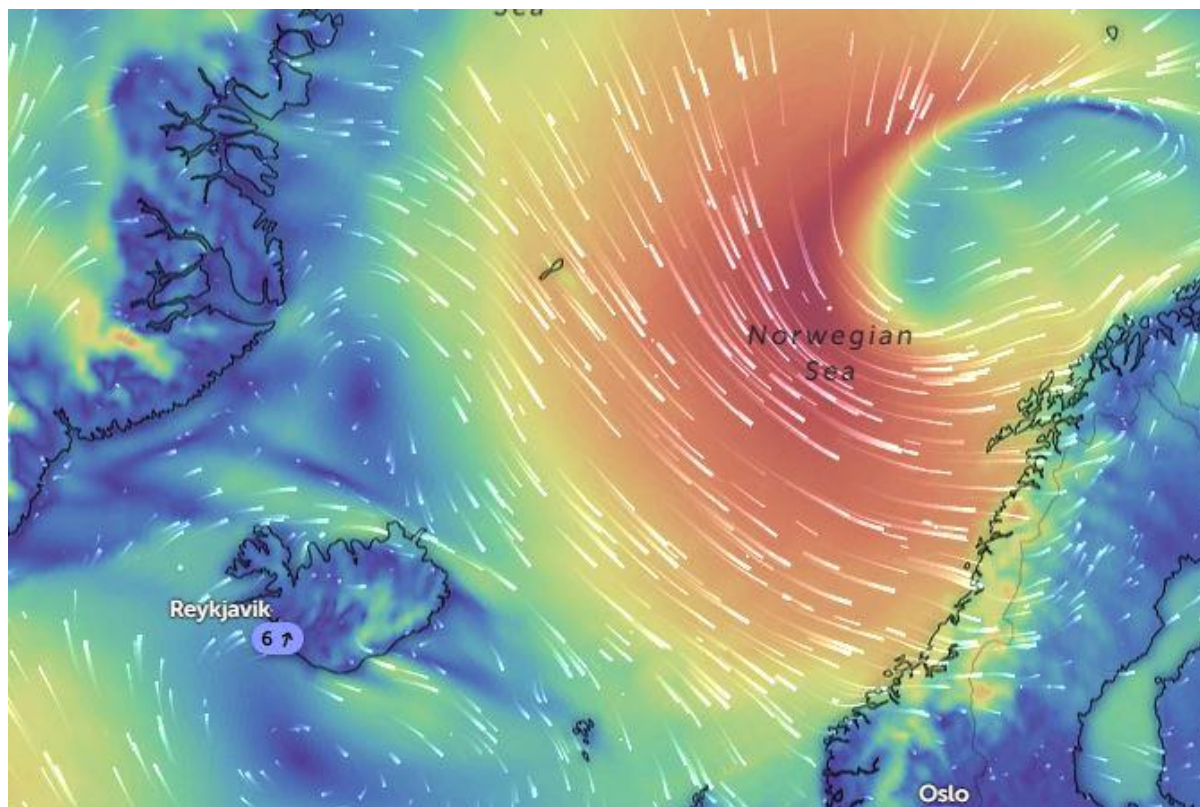


Severe Weather Risk across Norway



Affected Areas

Coastal and inland areas of Norway, Sweden, Finland, Norwegian Sea

Hazard Types

Strong winds, heavy precipitation, widespread snow inland and in northern areas

Summary

An extratropical low pressure system is developing across the Norwegian sea that is expected to bring widespread strong to damaging winds as it cuts inland over Norway and then heads down into Sweden and Finland. Hazardous marine conditions are expected, with very rough to high seas and dangerous conditions for shipping and coastal activities. As the system moves inland, it will bring periods of heavy precipitation, falling as rain at lower elevations and snow inland and across higher terrain, with blowing snow and reduced visibility in colder areas.
