

Hazard Summary

Severe heat conditions are currently impacting central Algeria and southern Libya, with peak temperatures reaching 41°C in Ghardaia and 39°C in Sabha. Warm, dry winds across the Sahara are intensifying heat stress, particularly in remote areas of northern Niger and southern Algeria. Urban centers like Tripoli and Benghazi are also experiencing elevated temperatures, though slightly lower. Stay hydrated and in shaded or air-conditioned environment, watch for symptoms of heat exhaustion and heatstroke.
