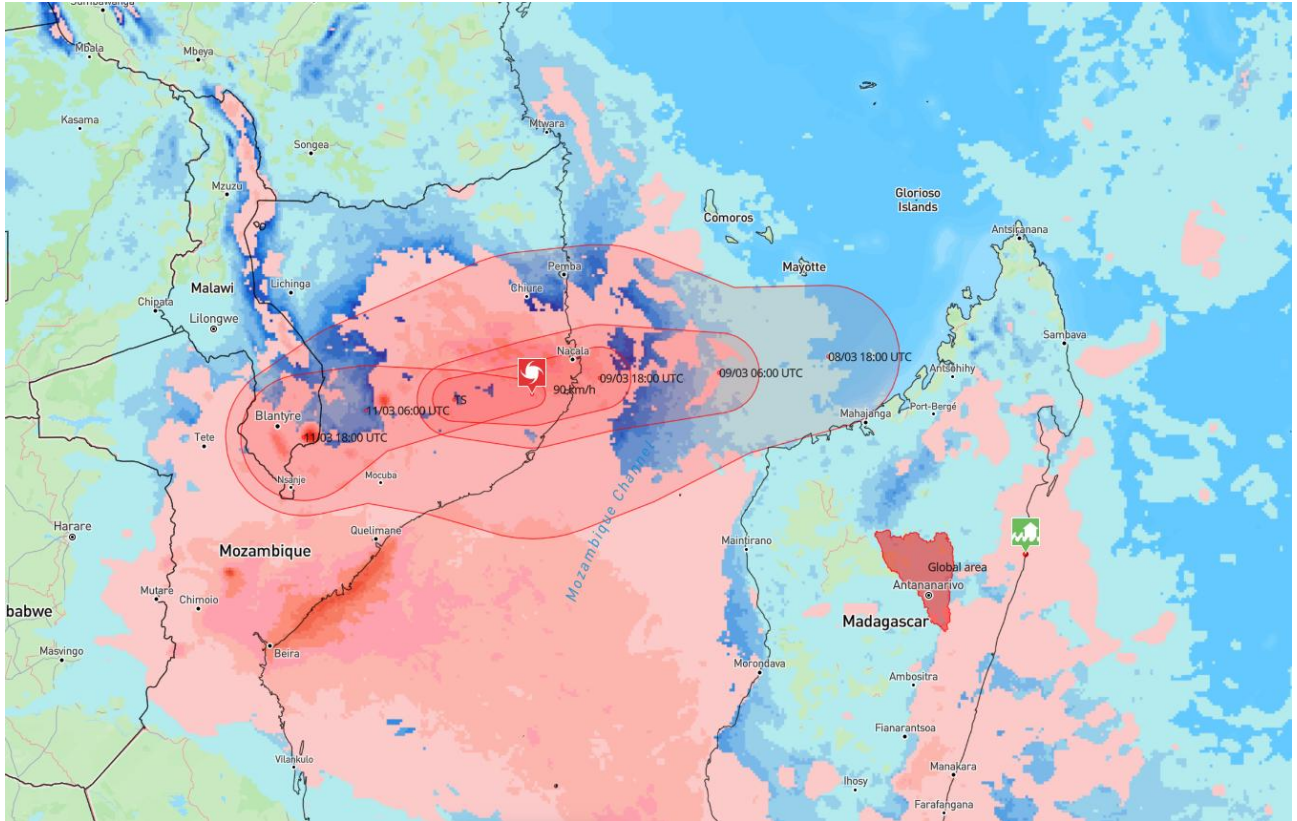

Tropical Cyclone JUDE-25 in Mozambique

Hazard Summary

As of March 11, 2025, Tropical Cyclone Jude has made landfall in Mozambique's Nampula province, near Nacala, bringing heavy rainfall and strong winds to the region. The storm is moving westward across northern Mozambique toward southern Malawi, weakening as it progresses. Authorities have reported infrastructure damage, including downed electricity pylons affecting approximately 40,000 customers, and have closed schools and canceled flights in the affected areas. Residents are advised to remain vigilant due to the ongoing threat of heavy rains and potential flooding. The Mozambican relief body, the National Disaster Management Institute (INGD), estimates that over 341,000 people in the province are at high risk from the cyclone. Additionally, Tanzania's weather authority has issued alerts for enhanced rainfall in various areas due to the presence of Tropical Cyclone Jude over the Indian Ocean in the Mozambique Channel.
