

Widespread Thunderstorm & Heavy Rainfall Alert – Africa



Valid: For Next week (from 4th to 11th March 2026)

Affected Areas

Southern Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana, southern Nigeria, Cameroon, Democratic Republic of the Congo, western Tanzania. Southern & eastern Mozambique, eastern Zimbabwe, and central–eastern Madagascar. Eastern South Africa including KwaZulu-Natal, Mpumalanga, and Gauteng.

Hazard Types

Severe Thunderstorms, Heavy to Intense Rainfall, Flash Flooding, Gusty Winds

Hazard Summary

Wide-spread convective rainfall linked to an active trough and embedded low pressure. Moderate to high instability and high moisture support efficient rainfall. Expect intense downpours, flash flooding in low-lying areas, localized river flooding, hail, and damaging winds over central and eastern provinces. Rainfall may extend into Western Cape, including Cape Town, with moderate to heavy rain and gusty coastal winds. Impacts may escalate after two days.
