

Rainfall & Flood Risk Forecast - Southern Peru



Hazard Summary

Forecast indicates persistent moderate to locally heavy rainfall across southern Peru. The highest rainfall potential is expected over southern Peruvian regions including Madre de Dios, Puno, Cusco, and adjacent areas. These conditions may lead to localized flash flooding, rising river levels, and landslides, particularly in low-lying zones, river basins, and steep terrain, where short-duration intense rainfall could trigger rapid runoff.
