


## Cyclone Development – Northern Australia



Valid: From March 2<sup>nd</sup> to March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2026

### Affected Areas:

Most affected areas include: Kimberley coast (Broome region), Northern Territory Top End, and the Gulf of Carpentaria coast. Moreover, severely affected are: Northern Western Australia and east of Queensland.

### Hazard Types

Tropical cyclone conditions; Intense rainfall; Destructive winds; Storm surge and coastal inundation; Flash flooding; Marine and aviation disruption.

### Hazard Summary

A well-organized tropical low over northern Australian waters is exhibiting sustained cyclonic circulation with deep convection. Favorable oceanic heat content and low vertical wind shear are supporting further intensification, along northern coastlines.
