



## Heavy Rainfall Flooding Wales UK



### Affected Areas

Aberdaron, Capel Curig, Swansea, Carmarthen and Wales

### Hazard Types

Heavy Rainfall/Flood

### Hazard Summary

High winds and heavy rain have battered Wales overnight, leading to flooding, power cuts, and major travel disruption. The Met Office has issued a yellow weather warning for strong winds across all of Wales until 18:00 BST. Gusts have reached 66mph in Aberdaron (Gwynedd) and 59mph in Capel Curig (Conwy), posing risks to transport and infrastructure. In Swansea, flooding submerged vehicles on Cwmbwrla roundabout, with further disruption expected. Residents are advised to travel only, if necessary, stay clear of floodwaters, and follow official weather updates.
