**Subject: Rain-wind / Thundershower predicted in upper & central parts from weekend (Monsoon likely to remain in active phase during 10-14 July 2021)**

- a. Respective PDMA's to coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, FWO and C&W) for restoration of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction.
  - b. Tourists/ Visitors in the area be apprised about weather forecast.
  - c. Availability of staff of emergency services be ensured.
  - d. Coordinate with relevant district and municipal administration to ensure mitigation measures for urban flooding and to secure or remove billboards / hoardings in light of thunderstorm / high winds.
  - e. Residents of landslide prone areas be apprised about the threat.
  - f. In case of any eventuality, twice daily updates should be shared with NDMA.

**RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSHOWER PREDICTED IN UPPER & CENTRAL PARTS FROM**  
**WEEKEND (MONSOON LIKELY TO REMAIN IN ACTIVE PHASE DURING 10-14 JULY**  
**2021)**

Met Office informed that strong monsoon currents are likely to penetrate northeastern parts of the country from weekend. Under the influence of this weather system:

- Rain-wind-thundershower (with few heavy falls at time) is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Sargodha, Mianwali, Khushab, Bhakkar and Layyah from 10-14 July 2021.
- Rain-wind-thundershowers (with few heavy falls at time) is expected in Dir, Swat, Buner, Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Swabi, Charsadda, Nowshera, Peshawar, Waziristan, Kurrum, Bannu, Kohat, Lakki Marwat, Tank, Karak and Dera Ismail Khan, Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamer, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza Nagar, Ghanche and Kharmang) from 11-14 July 2021.
- Rain/wind-thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Khanewal, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur and Rahim Yar Khan, Sibbi, Kohlu, Loralai, Barkhan, Sukkar, Jaccobabad, Tharparker, Sanghar and Mirpurkhas from 12-14 July 2021.

**Possible Impacts:**

- Heavy rains may generate flash flooding and may trigger landslides in the vulnerable areas of Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan, Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhuwa from Monday to Wednesday.
- Urban flooding in Rawalpindi, Lahore, Gujranwala, Peshawar and Faisalabad on Monday & Tuesday.
- Possibility of damaging effects due to wind-storm during the forecast period.
- Prevailing water stress in rainfed areas likely to subside and improvement in water reservoirs during the period.
- Prevailing hot & humid weather conditions likely to subside during the wet spell.

**Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” during the forecast period.**

- Rain/wind-thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Khanewal, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur and Rahim Yar Khan, Sibbi, Kohlu, Loralai, Barkhan, Sukkar, Jaccobabad, Tharparker, Sanghar and Mirpurkhas from Monday (evening/night) to Wednesday.

- پچ (شام/رات) سے ہفتے کے دوران ڈیرہ غازی خان، راجن پور، ملتان، خانیوال، ساہیوال، بہاولنگر، بہاولپور اور رحیم یار خان، سی، کوٹلو، لورالائی، بارکھان، سکھر، جیکب آباد، تھرپاکر، ساکنڈر اور میرپور خاص میں بھی آندھی اور کرن چٹک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش کی بھی توقع۔
