**SUBJECT: -RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:****I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST:**

River Chenab at Khanki & Qadirabad is in medium flood level. River Indus at Tarbela, River Chenab at Marala & River Ravi at Jassar are in low flood level.

**II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeastern parts of Afghanistan and adjoining areas today lies over Northern parts of the country.
- b. Yesterday's monsoon low over Northwest Bay of Bagel remained stationary.
- c. Weak Monsoon currents from Bay of Bengal are penetrating to upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet, these are likely to become moderate to strong during next 03-days.
- d. Weak Seasonal low lies over Balochistan.

**III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered wind thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers, Punjab along with Islamabad and Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, D.I Khan, Zhob, Loralai, Sibbi, Nasirabad & Kalat Divisions. Isolated wind thunderstorm/rain is also expected over Sindh.

**IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:**

Current Monsoon activity over the country is likely to continue.

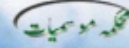
