

Subject: **DUST-THUNDERSTORM/RAIN PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS FROM 10<sup>TH</sup> (EVENING) TO 12<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2026**

Pakistan Met Department (**Annex-A**) predicted that a fresh **Westerly wave** is likely to approach **Northwestern** parts of the country on **10<sup>th</sup> May 2026** and likely to persist in upper parts till **12<sup>th</sup> May (night) 2026**. Under the influence of this weather system:-

- a. **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**. **Dust-thunderstorm/ rain** is expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kalam, Shangla, Buner, Kohistan, Malakand, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Balakot, Haripur, Swabi, Mardan, Nowshera, Charsadda, Peshawar, Bajaur, Mohmand, Orakzai, Khyber, Kohat, Kurram, Hangu, Karak from **10<sup>th</sup> (evening) to 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026** with occasional gaps.
  - b. **Punjab/Islamabad**. **Dust-thunderstorm/ rain** is expected in Murree, Galiyat, Islamabad / Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Bhakkar, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Jhang, Lahore, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal from **10<sup>th</sup> (evening) to 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026** with occasional gaps.
  - c. **Gilgit Baltistan**. **Rain-wind/ thunderstorm** is expected in (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Guaniche, Shigar) from **11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2026** with occasional gaps.
  - d. **Kashmir**. **Rain-wind/ thunderstorm** is expected in Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2026** with occasional gaps.
  - e. **Sindh/ South Punjab/ part of Balochistan/**. Dust-thunderstorm and rain are likely to bring relief from hot weather in upper parts while **very hot weather condition** is expected to continue in **Southern parts**
2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -
- a. Windstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc.) during the forecast period.
  - b. Farmers are advised to manage their crops in accordance with the duststorm and rain, especially during wheat harvesting.
  - c. Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir during the forecast period.
  - d. Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.

3. All concerned Federal Ministries/ Departments, respective Provincial Governments, their line departments including PDMAs/ GBDMA/ SDMA/ ICT Administration, DDMA/ local administrations, municipal authorities of major metropolises are advised to **ensure all necessary measures**.

**Dust-thunderstorm/rain predicted in upper parts with occasional gaps from 10<sup>th</sup> (evening) to 12<sup>th</sup> May**

Met office predicted that a fresh westerly wave is likely to approach northwestern parts of the country on 10<sup>th</sup> May and likely to persist in upper parts till 12<sup>th</sup> May (night). Under the influence of this weather system:

- Dust-thunderstorm/rain is expected in Kyber Pakhtunkhwa (Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kalam, Shangla, Buner, Kohistan, Malakand, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Balakot, Haripur, Swabi, Mardan, Nowshera, Charsadda, Peshawar, Bajaur, Mohmand, Orakzai, Khyber, Kohat, Kurram, Hangu, Karak), Punjab/Islamabad (Murree, Galiyat, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Khushab, Joharabad, Sargodha, Mianwali, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Jhang, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Okara, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal) from 10<sup>th</sup> (evening) to 12<sup>th</sup> May with occasional gaps. While rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in Gilgit Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Guanache, Shigar), Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> May with occasional gaps.
- Dust-thunderstorm and rain are likely to bring relief from hot weather in upper parts while very hot weather condition is expected to continue in southern parts (south Punjab, Sindh, and parts of Baluchistan).

**Possible Impacts and advises:**

- Windstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc.) during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crops in accordance with the duststorm and rain, especially during wheat harvesting.
- Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir during the forecast period.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.

**Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "Vigilant" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period.**

## 10 (شام) سے 12 مئی کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں وقفے وقفے سے آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی پیش گوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کی پیش گوئی کے مطابق ایک مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ 10 مئی کو ملک کے شمال مغربی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کا امکان ہے اور یہ 12 مئی (رات تک) بالائی علاقوں میں برقرار رہنے کی توقع ہے۔ اس موسمی نظام کے زیر اثر:

- 10 (شام) سے 12 مئی کے دوران خیبر پختونخواہ: (چترال، دیر، سوات، کالام، شانگلہ، بونیر، کوہستان، ملاکنڈ، بنگرام، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، بالا کوٹ، ہری پور، صوابی، مردان، نوشہرہ، چارسدہ، پشاور، ہاچو، مہمند، اورکزئی، خیبر، کوہاٹ، کرم، ہنگو اور کرک)، پنجاب/اسلام آباد: (مری، گلیات، اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی، انک، چکوال، جہلم، خوشاب، جوہر آباد، سرگودھا، میانوالی، فیصل آباد، ساہیوال، جہنگ، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، اوکاڑہ، گوجرانوالہ، سیالکوٹ اور نادر وال) میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ جبکہ 11 سے 13 مئی کے دوران گلگت بلتستان: (دیامر، استور، غدر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچے اور شکر)، کشمیر: (واہی نیلم، مظفر آباد، پونچھ، ہٹیاں، باغ، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، بھمبر اور میرپور) میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔

- بالائی علاقوں میں آندھی / تیز ہواؤں اور بارش سے گرم موسم کی شدت میں کمی کی توقع ہے۔ جبکہ جنوبی علاقوں (جنوبی پنجاب، سندھ اور بلوچستان کے بعض علاقوں) میں موسم شدید گرم رہنے کا امکان ہے۔

### محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- اس دوران تیز ہواؤں اور آسانی بجلی کرنے کے باعث کمزور ڈھانچوں (بجلی کے سمبے، بل بورڈز، سولر ہلڈز وغیرہ) کو نقصان پہنچنے کا خطرہ ہے۔
- کاشتکار حضرات کو ہدایت کی جاتی ہے کہ وہ گرد آلود ہواؤں آندھی اور بارش کے پیش نظر بالخصوص مگنم کی کٹائی کے دوران اپنی فصلوں کی دیکھ بھال موسمی حالات کے مطابق کریں۔
- پیش گوئی کے دوران بالائی خیبر پختونخوا، گلگت بلتستان اور کشمیر کے پہاڑی علاقوں میں لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کا خطرہ ہے۔
- اس دوران سیاحوں اور مسافروں کو محتاط رہنے اور غیر ضروری سفر سے اجتناب کی ہدایت ہے۔

نوٹ: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو "الٹ" رہنے اور کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
