Met Office informed that moist currents from the Arabian Sea are likely to penetrate in eastern parts of the Country from Friday (evening/night). Under the influence of this weather system:

- Rain-wind/thunderstorm (with few moderate to isolated heavy falls) is expected in Kashmir, GilgitBaltistan (Astore, Kharmang, Ghanche and Shigar), Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Narowal, Sialkot, Lahore, Kasur, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Nowshera, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Mardan, Buner, Dir, Shangla and Kohistan from Friday (evening/night) to Monday.
- Rain-wind/thunderstorm in Sargodha, Bhakkar, Layyah, Khushab, Mianwali, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Multan, Sahiwal, Dera Ghazi Khan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Barkhan, Musa Khel and Zhob during Saturday (evening/night) to Sunday.

Note:

- Prevailing very hot weather conditions are likely to subside during the wet-spell
- Wind thunderstorm with heavy falls at times may generate urban flooding in low-lying areas of Lahore Gujranwala, Sialkot, Jhelum and Rawalpindi on Saturday/Sunday

Impacts:

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق جمعہ کے روز (شام/رات) سے مرطوب ہوائیں بحیرہ عرب سے ملک کے شمال مشرقی علاقوں میں داخل ہو گئی۔ جس کے باعث:

- جمعہ (شام/رات) سے پیر کے دوران کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان (استور، کرمنگ، گھانچی اور شگر)، اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، مری، انک، چکوال، جہلم، گوجرانوالہ، گجرات، حافظ آباد، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، نارووال، سیالکوٹ، لاہور، قصور، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، ہری پور، نوشہرہ، پشاور، کوہاٹ، بنوں، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، مردان، بونیر، دیر، شانگلہ اور کوہستان میں آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش۔ اس دوران بعض مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش کی پیش گوئی۔
- ہفتہ (شام/رات) سے اتوار کے دوران سرگودھا، بھکر، لیہ، خوشاب، میانوالی، فیصل آباد، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، ملتان، ساہیوال، ڈیرہ غازی خان، بہاولپور، بہاولنگر، بارکھان، موسی خیل اور ژوب میں بھی آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔

اثرات:

- بارش کے باعث حالیہ گرمی کی لہر میں کمی کا امکان۔
- ہفتہ/اتوار کے روز آندھی اور تیز بارش کے باعث لاہور، گوجرانوالہ، سیالکوٹ، جہلم اور راولپنڈی میں نشیبی علاقے زیر آب آنے کا خدشہ۔
