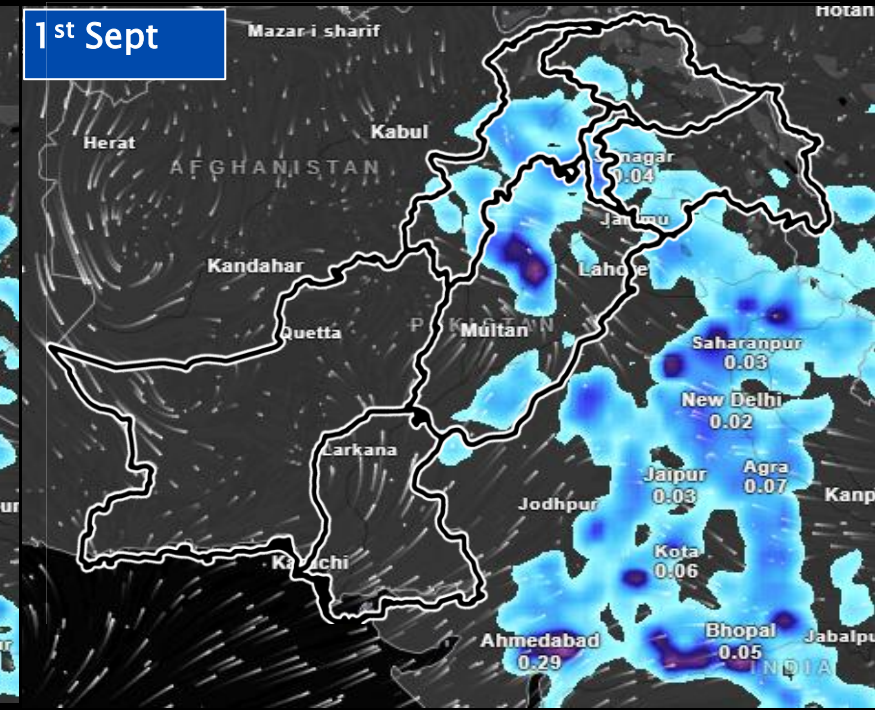
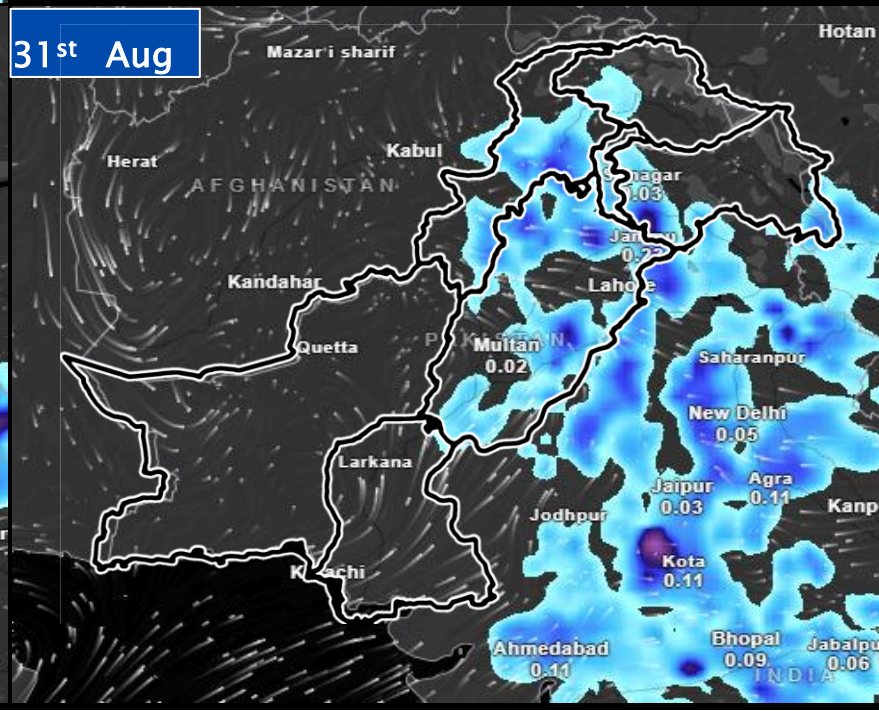
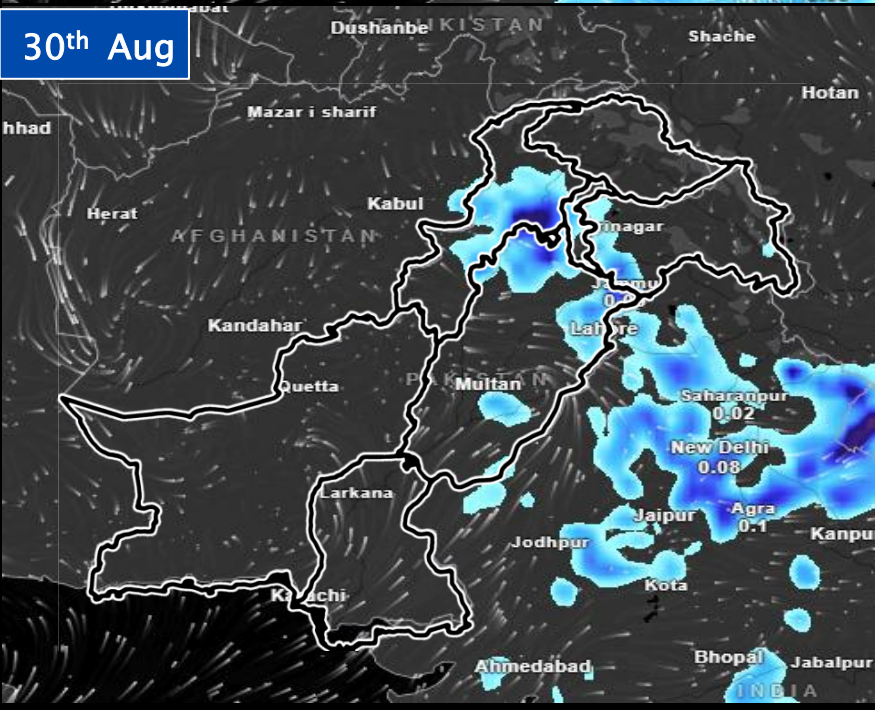
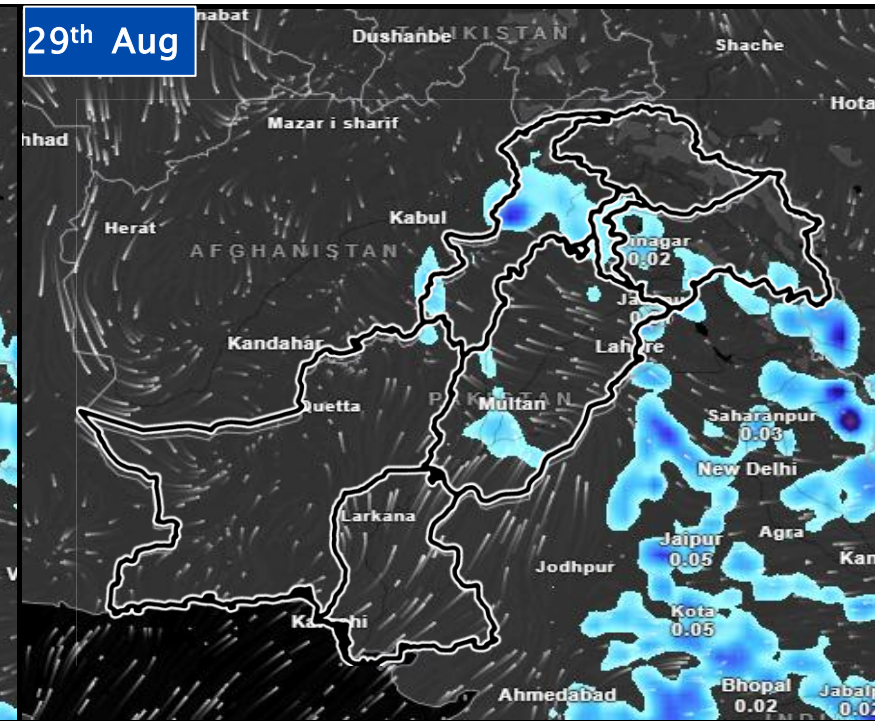
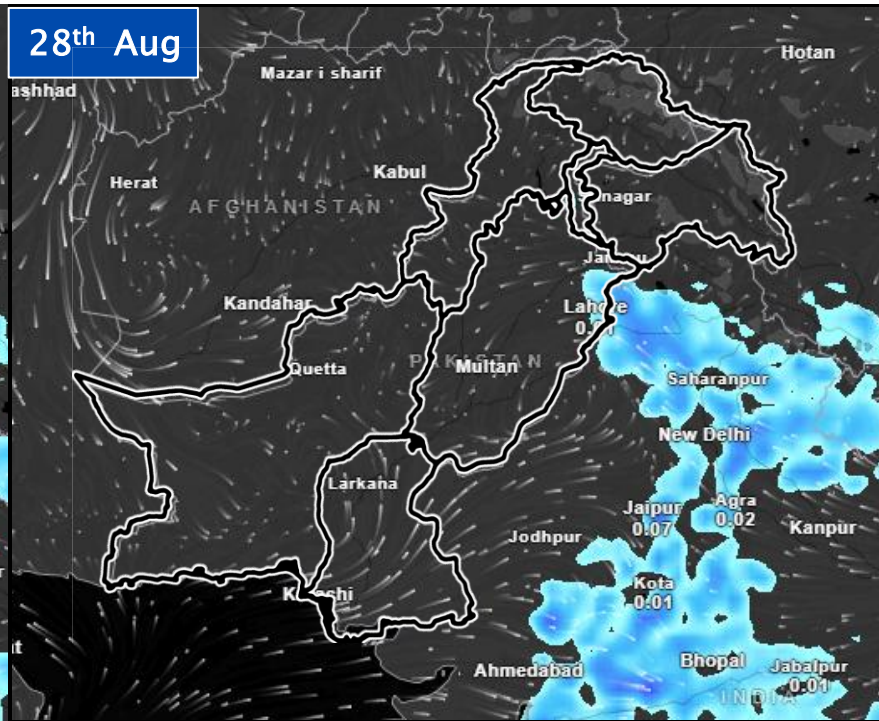
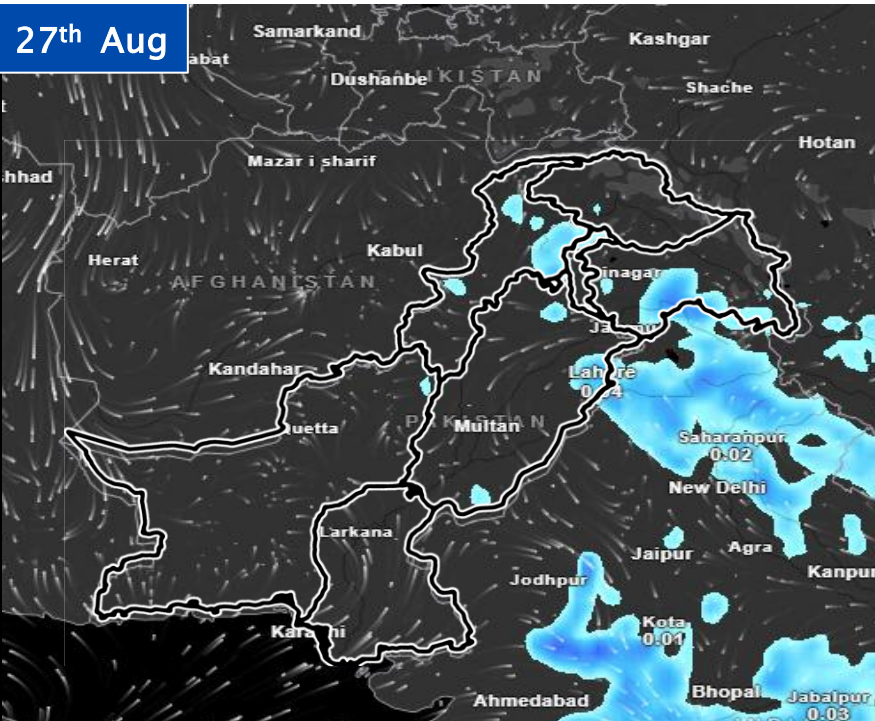




Weather Advisory (27th Aug to 1st Sept, 2025)

Moisture from the Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea is expected to bring moderate to heavy rainfall in most parts of the country from 29th of August to 2nd of September, 2025.

Punjab:

Moderate to heavy rainfall, and thunderstorms are expected in upper and northeastern parts of the province including Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Hafizabad, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Okara, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahim yar Khan, Dera Ghazi Kahn, and surrounding areas from 29th of August to 1st of September, 2025 with occasional gaps.

Balochistan:

Isolated rainfall and thunderstorm is expected Ziarat, Kalat, Musakhel, Khuzdar, Awaran, Barkhan Sibbi, Jaffarabad, Dera Bugti, and surrounding areas from 29th of August to 1st of September.

Sindh:

Isolated moderate rainfall and thunderstorm is expected in Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Karachi, Hyderabad, Tharparkar, Thatta, Badin, Mirpur Khas, and surrounding areas from 30th of August to 1st of September

KP:

Moderate to heavy rainfall and thunderstorm is expected in Chitral, Dir, Haripur, Karak, Kohat, Kohistan, Khyber, Kurram, Mansehra, Mohmand, Nowshera, Malakand, Charsadda, Abbottabad, Bannu, Buner, Hazara, Peshawar, Swabi, Swat, Waziristan, and surrounding areas from 29th of August to 1st of September.

GB & AJK:

Isolated rainfall is expected in Astore, Skardu, Hunza, Shigar, Bagh, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, and surrounding areas from 29th of August to 1st of September.
