

Weather Advisory (12th to 17th July, 2025) National Emergency Operation Centre – National Disaster Management Authority



Moisture from the Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea is expected to bring moderate to heavy rainfall in most parts of the country during this week.

Punjab:

Widespread rainfall is expected in upper and northeastern parts of the province including Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Hafizabad, Narowal, Okara, Lahore, and Kasur from 11th to 17th of July, 2025. However, rainfall is expected in southern parts including Multan, Khanewal, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahim yar Khan, Dera Ghazi Kahn, and surrounding areas from 13th to 17th of July, 2025.

Balochistan:

Rainfall and thunderstorm is expected Ziarat, Kalat, Zhob, Quetta, Sherani, Musakhel, Khuzdar, Awaran, Barkhan Sibbi, Jaffarabad, Dera Bugti, and surrounding areas from 13th to 16th of July, 2025.

Sindh:

Isolated moderate rainfall and thunderstorm is expected in Sukkur, Larkana, Dadu, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Hyderabad, Karachi, Tharparkar, Thatta, Badin, Mirpur Khas, and surrounding areas from 15th to 17th of July, 2025.

KP:

Moderate to heavy rainfall and thunderstorm is expected in Chitral, Dir, Haripur, Karak, Kohat, Kohistan, Khyber, Kurram, Mansehra, Mohmand, Nowshera, Malakand, Charsadda, Abbottabad, Bannu, Buner, Hazara, Peshawar, Swabi, Swat, Waziristan, and surrounding areas from 12th to 17th of July, 2025

GB & AJK:

Rainfall is expected in Astore, Skardu, Hunza, Shighar, Bagh, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, and surrounding areas from 12th to 17th of July, 2025.
