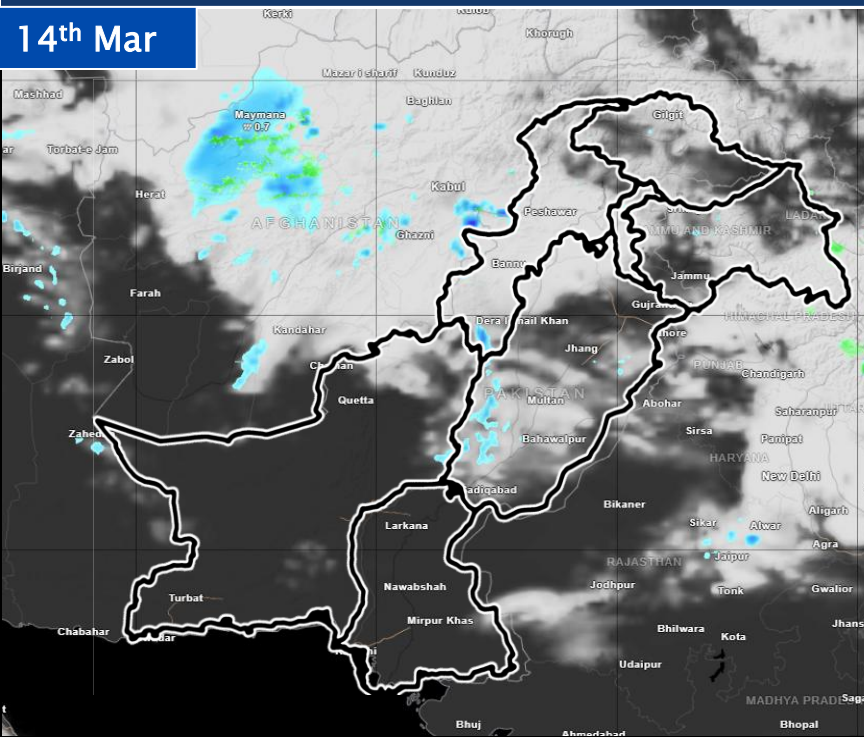




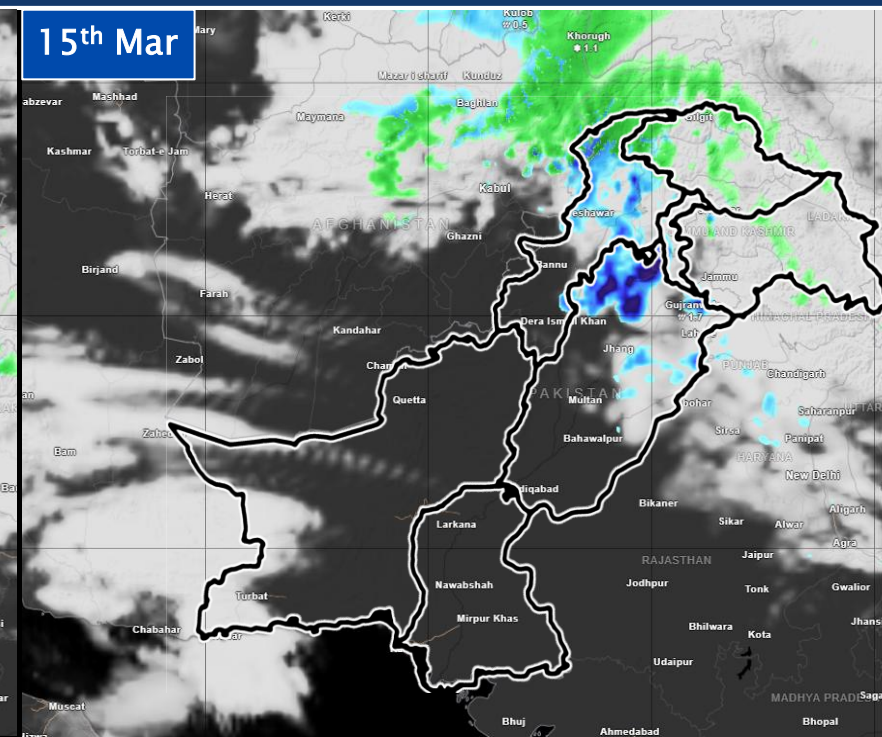

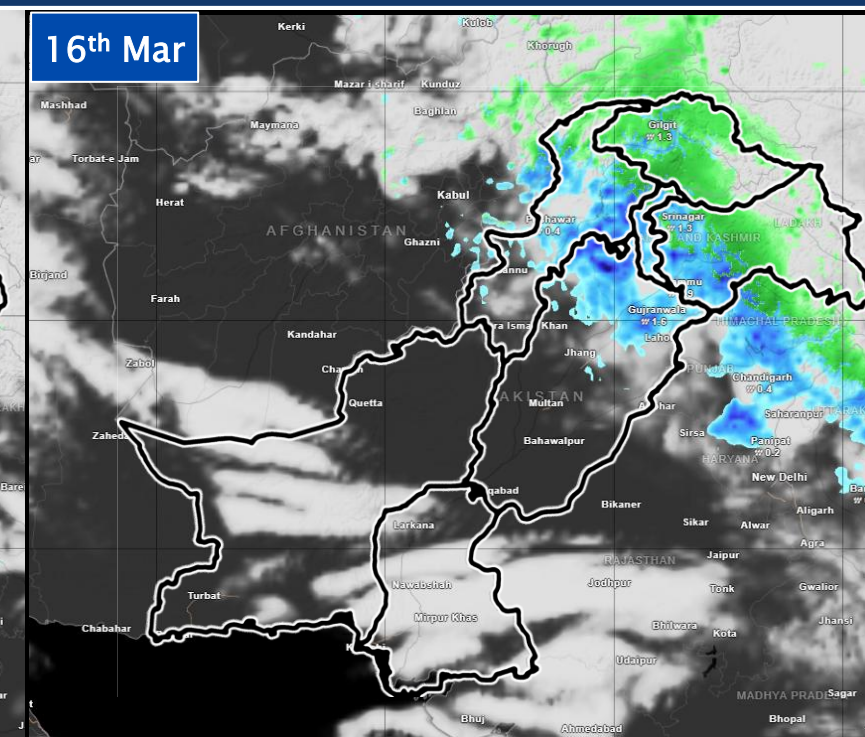

Punjab:

Mostly dry weather conditions are expected across the province. However, cloudy weather along with isolated rainfall and thunderstorms are expected in upper and central parts of the province including Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Lahore, and surrounding areas from 15th to 19th March, 2026 with occasional gaps. Day time temperatures are expected to remain above normal.

Balochistan:

Dry weather is expected all across the province. However, cloudy weather along with light rainfall is expected in northern parts of the province including Quetta, Zhob, Ziarat, Kalat, and surrounding areas on 14th March, and again from 18th to 19th March, 2026, with occasional gaps. Day time temperatures are expected to remain above normal.

Sindh:

Dry weather is expected all across the province. Day time temperatures are expected to remain above normal.

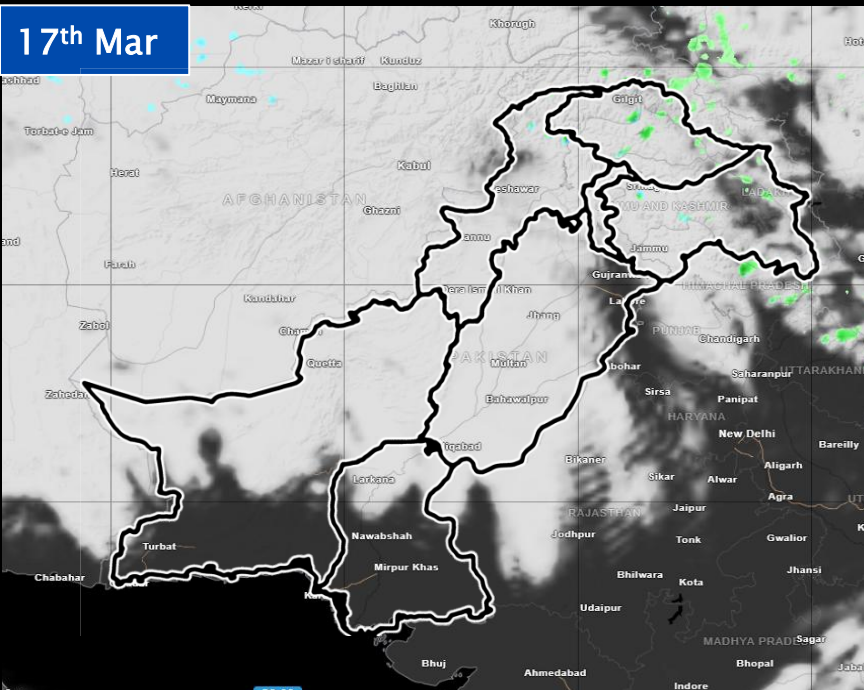
KE:

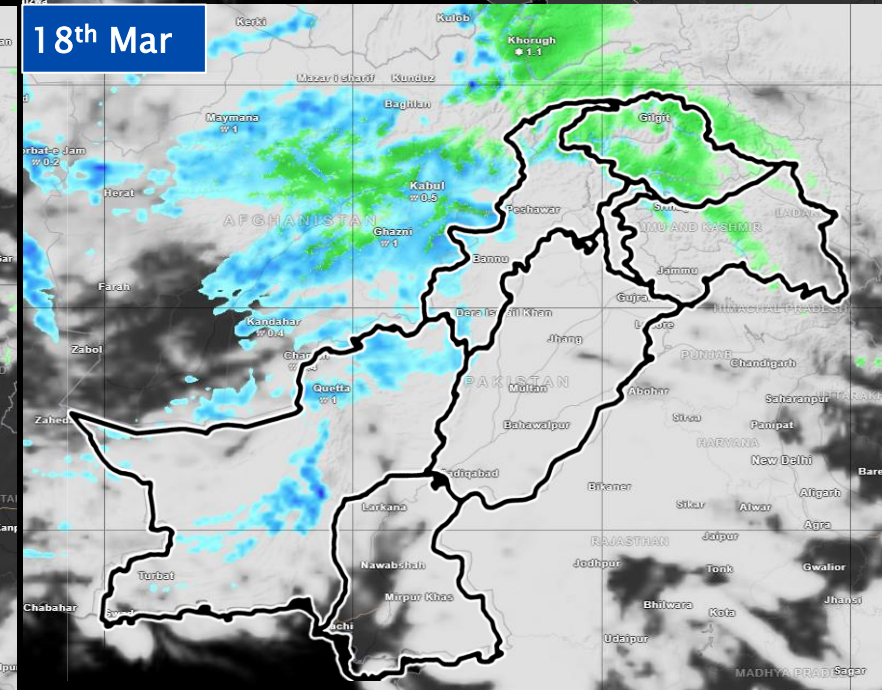
GB & AJK:
