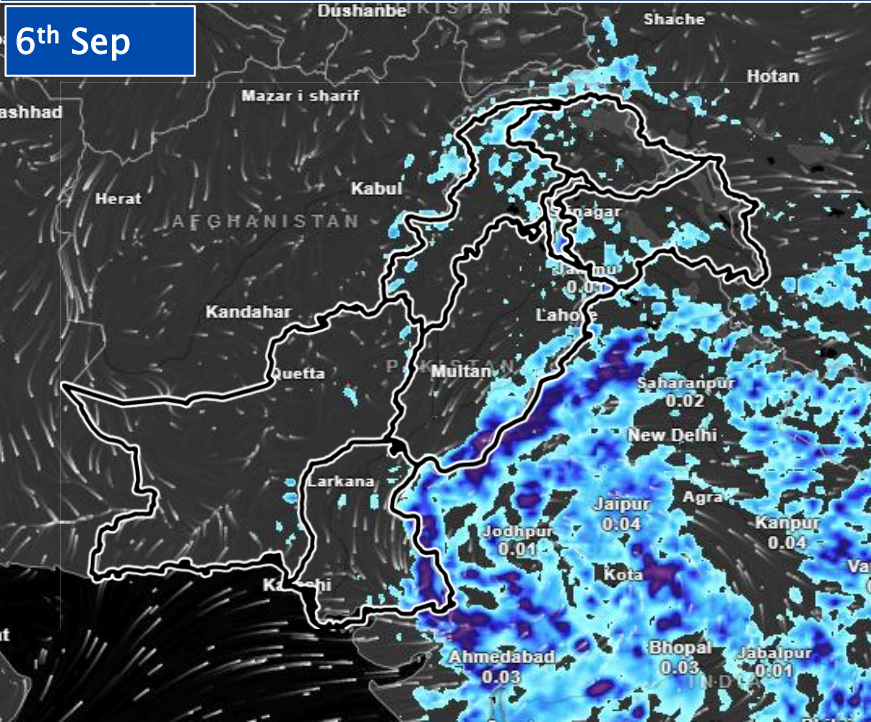




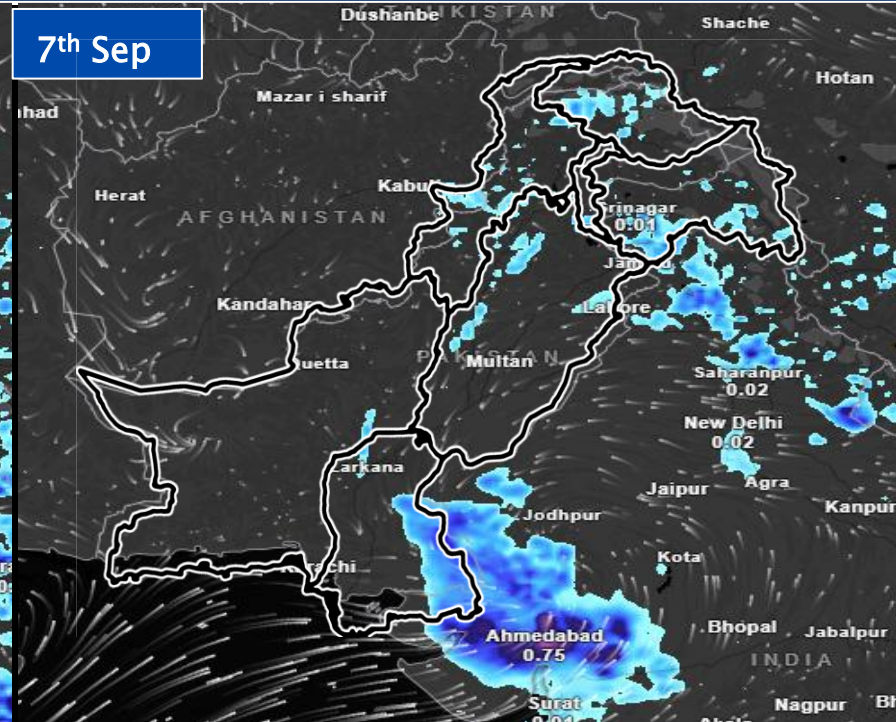

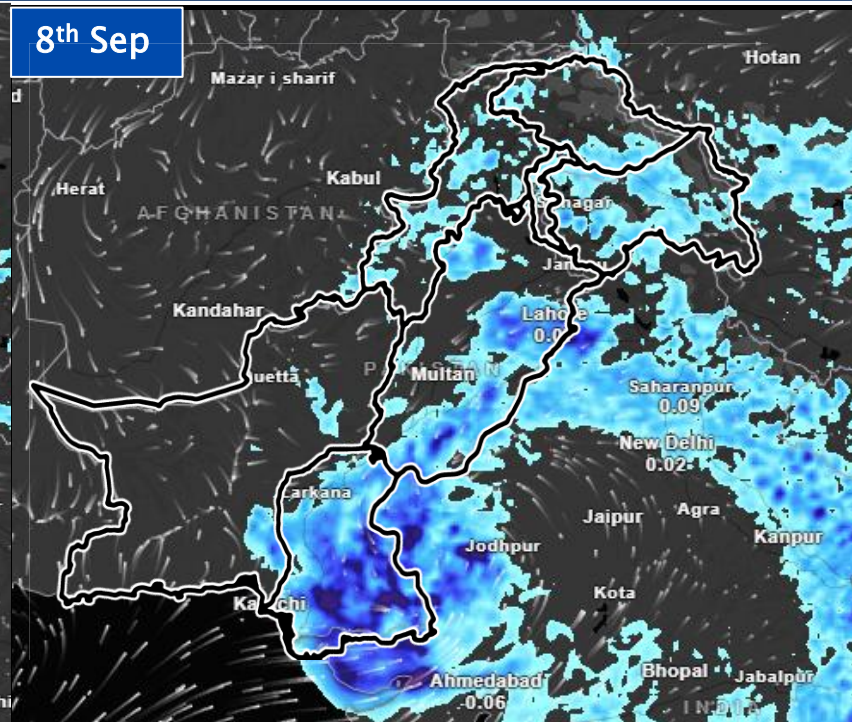

Moisture from the Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea is expected to bring heavy rainfall in southern parts of the country 6th to 9th of September, 2025.

Punjab:

Isolated rainfall is expected in upper and northeastern parts of the province including Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Okara, Lahore, Hafizabad, Gujranwala, Gujrat and surrounding areas. However, heavy rainfall is expected in southern parts including Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahim yar Khan, Rajanpur, Dera Ghazi Khan, and surrounding areas from 6th to 9th of September, 2025. The system may also activate hill torrents.

Balochistan:

Isolated rainfall is expected Ziarat, Kalat, Musakhel, Khuzdar, Awaran, Barkhan Sibbi, Jaffarabad, Dera Bugti, and surrounding areas from 7th to 9th of September, 2025. Isolated heavy falls are also expected during this time period.

Sindh:

Widespread heavy rainfall and thunderstorms are expected in most parts of the province including Tharparkar, Thatta, Badin, Mirpur Khas, Mithi, Umer Kot, Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Karachi, Kashmore, Dadu, Jacobabad, Sukkur, Larkana, Shaheed Benazirabad, Khairpur, and surrounding areas from 6th to 9th of September, 2025.

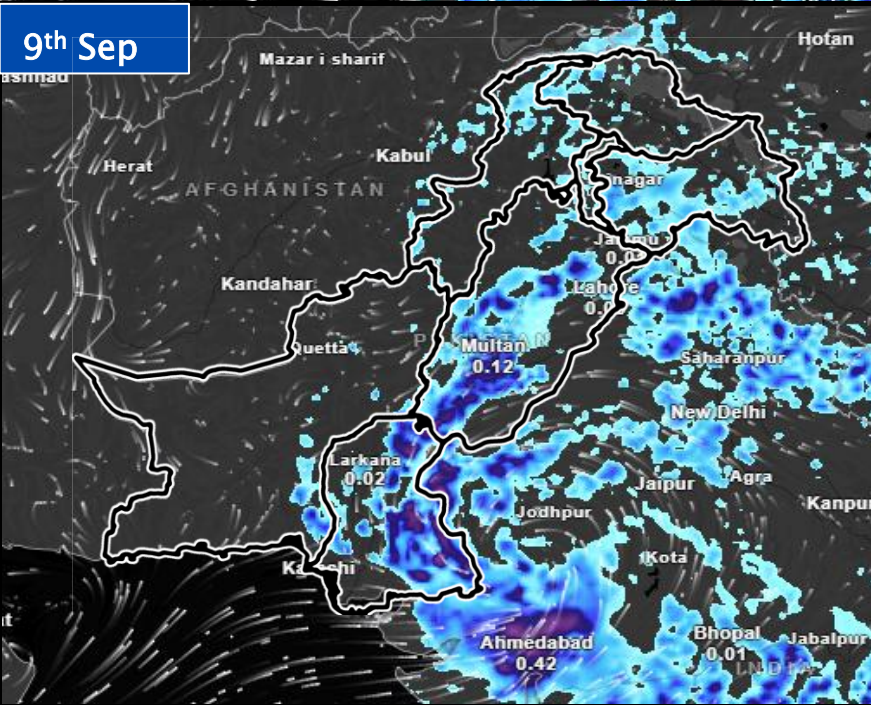
KP:

Isolated rainfall is expected in Chitral, Dir, Haripur, Kohat, Kohistan, Mansehra, Mohmand, Nowshera, Malakand, Charsadda, Abbottabad, Buner, Hazara, Peshawar, and surrounding areas from 7th to 9th of September.

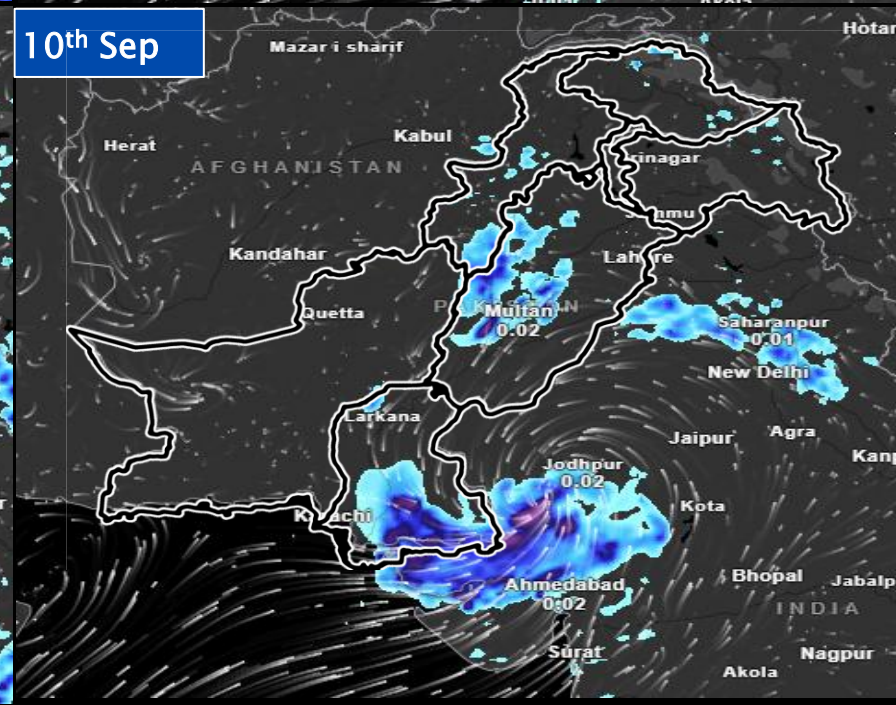
GB & AJK:

Isolated light rainfall is expected in Astore, Skardu, Hunza, Shigar, Bagh, Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, and surrounding areas from 6th to 8th of September, 2025.
