

Hazard Summary

A broad zone of intense rainfall is currently affecting the region around Dhamar in Yemen, with significant precipitation observed over areas including Sana'a, Ibb, Taiz, and Al Bayda. Accumulated rainfall totals may reach between 20 to 50 mm, with localized amounts possibly exceeding 60 mm. The color zones in the image indicate varying intensities of weather activity, with some areas at risk of strong winds and fluctuating atmospheric pressure. Residents in these areas should be alert for potential flash flooding and disruptions caused by changing weather conditions. Appropriate precautions are advised in low-lying and vulnerable areas.
