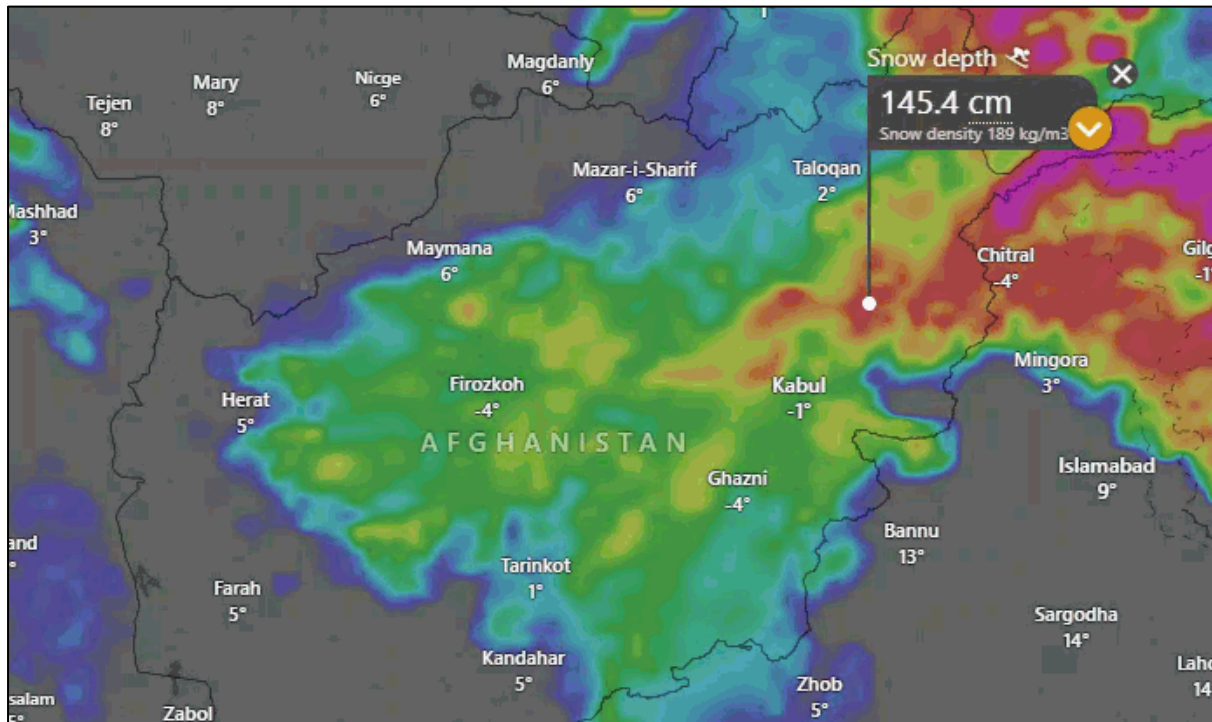




Severe Cold & Snow - Afghanistan



Valid: From January 26th to January 31st, 2026

Affected Areas

Most affected areas include: Central and northern provinces including Ghazni (peak snow depth \approx 155 cm), Nuristan, Kunar, Baghlan, Parwan, Logar, Bamyán, and Ghor. Also, severely impacted regions include Badakhshan, Takhar, Maidan Wardak, and the Salang Pass.

Hazard Types

Extreme cold wave & severe frost; Mass casualty events; Livestock mortality and Infrastructure collapse; Respiratory illness outbreaks; Total transport paralysis (Salang highway closures); and downstream flash flood risks.

Hazard Summary

Afghanistan is facing a catastrophic winter surge with record-breaking snowfall (up to 155 cm) and sub-zero temperatures. The deep snow has isolated remote villages, killed over 60 people, and destroyed hundreds of mud-brick homes. This creates a life-threatening emergency for 18 million people requiring humanitarian aid.
