




## Severe Cold & Snow - Afghanistan



Valid: From January 26<sup>th</sup> to January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026

### Affected Areas

Most affected areas include: Central and northern provinces including Ghazni (peak snow depth  $\approx$  155 cm), Nuristan, Kunar, Baghlan, Parwan, Logar, Bamyan, and Ghor. Also, severely impacted regions include Badakhshan, Takhar, Maidan Wardak, and the Salang Pass.

### Hazard Types

Extreme cold wave & severe frost; Mass casualty events; Livestock mortality and Infrastructure collapse; Respiratory illness outbreaks; Total transport paralysis (Salang highway closures); and downstream flash flood risks.

### Hazard Summary

Afghanistan is facing a catastrophic winter surge with record-breaking snowfall (up to 155 cm) and sub-zero temperatures. The deep snow has isolated remote villages, killed over 60 people, and destroyed hundreds of mud-brick homes. This creates a life-threatening emergency for 18 million people requiring humanitarian aid.
