Current Situation

A deadly landslide event hit a residential area in the Bandung Barat region triggered by heavy rains with the confirmed death toll rising to 17 people according to the local authorities. More than 30 houses have been buried by the landslide with almost 73 people currently missing.

Hazard Summary

Persistent and ongoing rainfall is continuing to saturate soils, significantly increasing the risk of additional landslides and slope failures, particularly in steep, hilly, and deforested terrain. Further ground instability may occur with little warning. Residents in high-risk areas are advised to remain vigilant, avoid unstable slopes and riverbanks, follow instructions from local authorities, and be prepared for possible evacuations if heavy rainfall persists.
