




Major Storm Event for Morocco



Valid: 14-20 January, 2026

Affected Areas

Coastal and northern Morocco (Tangier, Casablanca, Rabat), central plains, Atlas Mountains, and areas near the Algerian border.

Hazard Types

Heavy rainfall, flash flooding, strong winds (gusts 70–90+ km/h), thunderstorms, and travel disruptions.

Summary

A significant Atlantic storm system will affect Morocco January 13–17, 2026. Peak impacts occur January 14–15 with heaviest rain in northern/central areas, snow in the Atlas, and strong coastal winds. Conditions ease after January 17. On January 18–20, a sharp reduction in precipitation intensity and coverage signals the end of the major storm phase.
