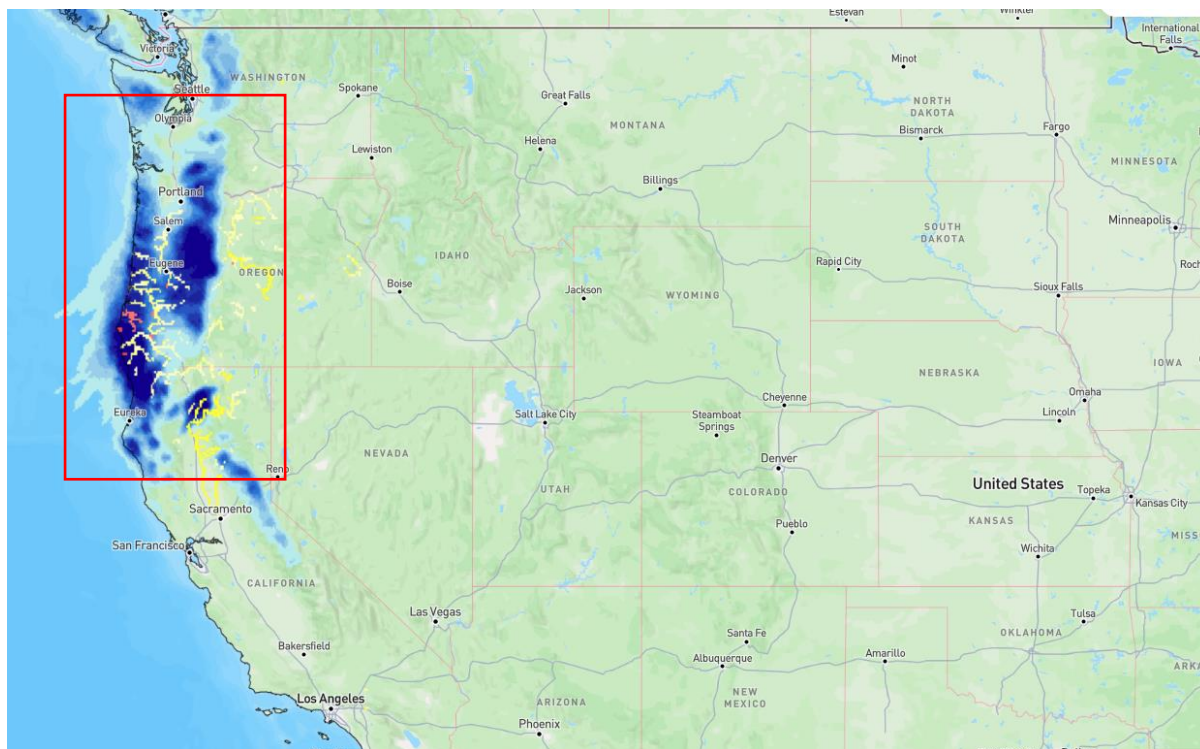

Hazard Type:

 Flash Floods – Rapid water accumulation in low-lying areas, riverbanks, and urban zones due to heavy rainfall, overflowing streams, and poor drainage.

Description: The flood risk map of the western United States highlights areas prone to flooding, with varying levels of susceptibility indicated by different colors. This distribution is influenced by topography, river networks, and precipitation patterns, with coastal and valley regions being the most susceptible to flooding.
